Unfortunately, while Sue was running towards home, she slipped away and fell on the ground. She hurt her leg badly and was in pain.




All friends ran to her and tried to help her. But she couldn't move as her leg was broken. They called their parents immediately.



Sue's mother came first and called the ambulance. All were upset by Sue's unexpected accident.


Ambulance came in two minutes and took her to the hospital.
