'La Castanyada' is our autumnal festival and to honour it we eat roasted chestnuts (castanyes), roasted sweet potatoes (boniatos) and sweets (panellets) made of almond flour, sugar, eggs and sweet potato. Panellets have different coatings, such as pine nuts, coconut flakes, almonds or they can be topped with a dollop of quince paste or a glacé cherry.
