
You are already registered on the platform. Is your profile updated? If not, please do it.

What we take into account to find a partner:

- To make a clear and specific proposal of what you want (Schedule)
- To publish a post on the Forum. Look for an attractive title to find a partner quickly.
- To write down your email address at the message on the forum.
- To choose the "partner" that suits you best (the one answering quickly, the one having stue of the same age as yours, the one with large project experience...)
- To make an agreement with your partner about the frequency of communication and how you will communicate.
- To decide if you will register the students on the Twinspace to communicate.

- ➤ We explore the Twinspace and start practising by: adding some pages, publishing information and embedding materials.

eTWINNING **PRACTICE**:

These are examples of activities which are usually included in eTwinning projects. Let's practise them!

- > Invite members and update profiles on the Twinspace.
- > ZeeMaps / Google My Maps. Locate the partners in the project
- > Twinspace Forums/Live Events. Communication, international workgroups
- > Puzzel.org. Ice-breaking activities for students
- > Popplet / Coggle. Create a mind-map with ideas to plan activities
- > Padlet / Twinboard. Cooperative space to share files, upload results, etc.
