Worksheet Biographies of French resistance fighters –
Telling their stories

Tasks

- 1 Form 6 smaller **international teams of 3-5 people**. There should be at least one group member from each of the three countries.
- 2 Each group takes **one biography of a resistance fighter** and each member reads the biography.
- 3 Get together (no matter on which platform seems right to you: Skype, discord, Zoom ...) and **discuss your ideas on which story you can create** to tell that person’s life or 1-2 events as a resistance fighter.
You may **write a story in whatever form you think best**: as a diary, a letter, an interview, a fictional story, a sort of conversation (blog) ...

To give you some ideas: you may think of one special event or mission that “your” person had to go through:

- working with others to plan the destruction of a railroad or blowing up Nazi trucks;
- hiding a persecuted person from being caught by the Germans;
- looking for and securing military material dropped on parachutes by the British;
- producing fake ID cards to help people flee from the Nazis;
- guiding people to hiding places without being caught by the Nazis
- ...

Be inventive and imagine you were a resistance fighter back then!
