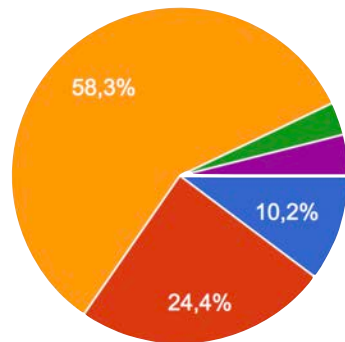
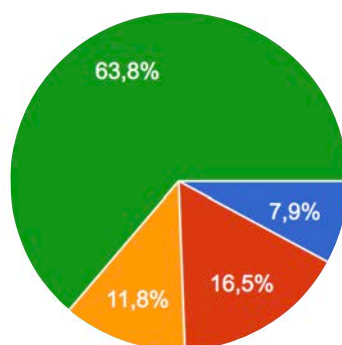


1. What does your school do to prevent exclusion?



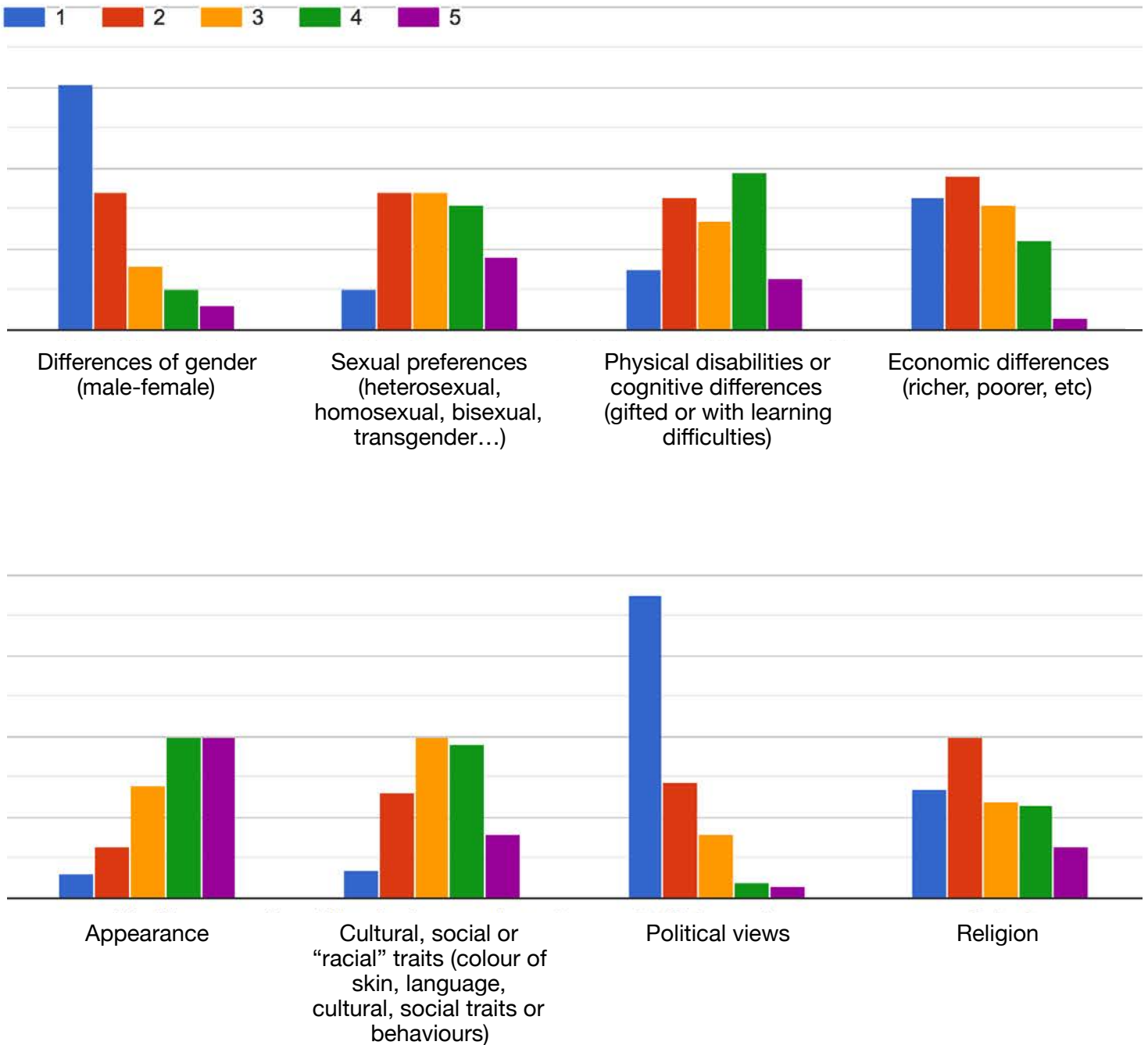
- Campaigns through educational programs delivered by specific cour...

2. How does the school deal with an actual problem of discrimination such as racism, gender discrimination or bullying?

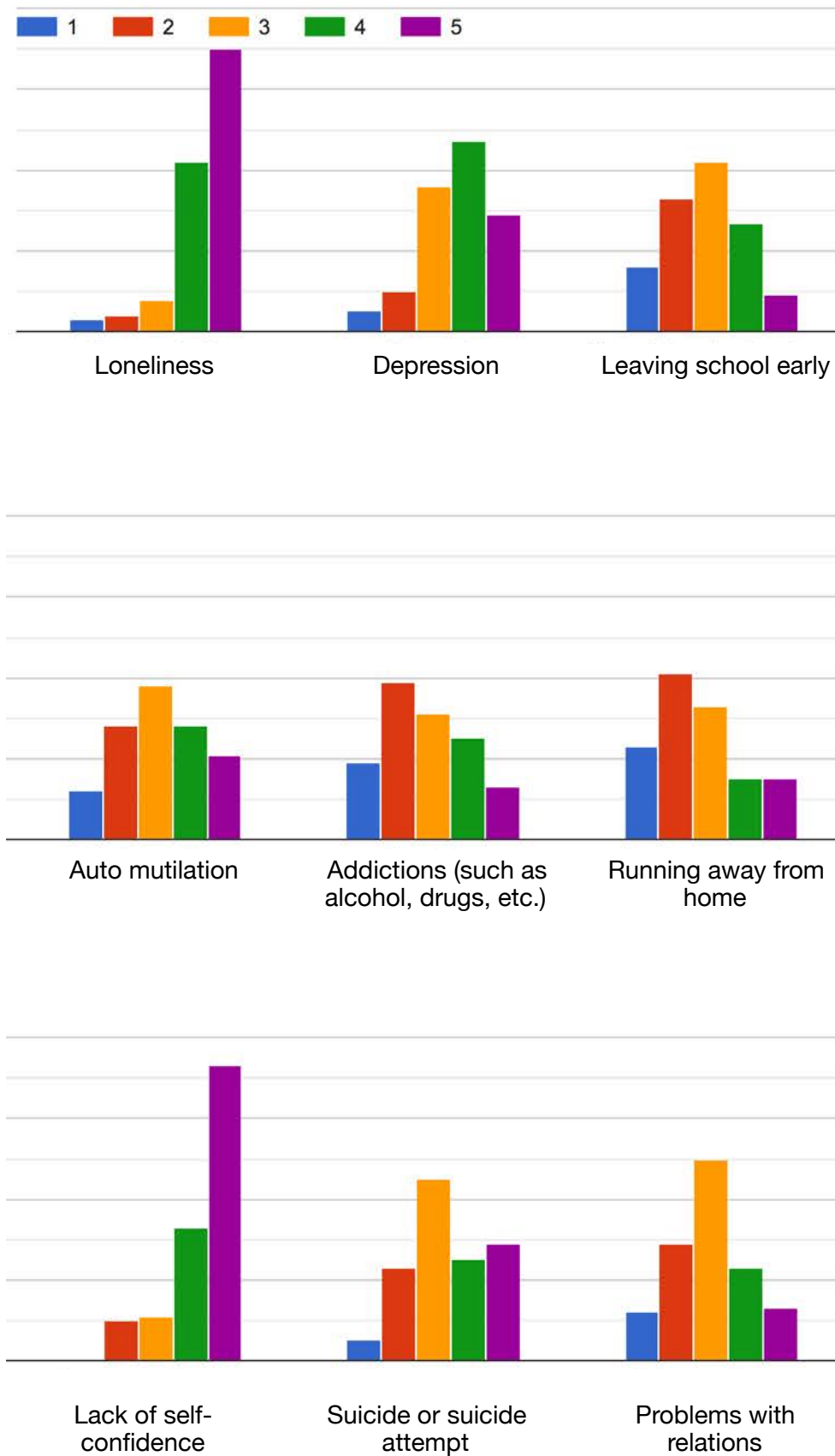
