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

- 15 partner schools and 75 participating kindergardens, primary and secondary schools, and student dorms
- It will last until 30. 9. 2021
- 4500 immigrant children and 6000 professionals will be involved
- **15** employed teachers and school counsellors multipliers


























What do we want to accomplish with the project?

- To train teachers and professionals for working with immigrant children,
- to help immigrant children and their families integrate into the new school and local environment,
- to implement and upgrade the existing practices for developing intercultural competences and for working with immigrant children and parents,
- to prepare a draft of a program for working with immigrant children in kindergarten, primary and secondary school (until 31. 8. 2018),
- to disseminate the project results in all levels of education,
- to contribute to a greater tolerance and a positive attitude towards interculturalism in society.

- An introductory course and program "For immigrant students in the new environment,"

- advanced courses in Slovene,






• Slovenian language learning for parents of immigrant children,

- developing supportive environments in the local community and the activation of the majority population.



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


