TURKISH MOBILITY PROGRAMME (IN PRIMDA, CZECH REPUBLIC) "TURKISH DAYS IN PRIMDA" (24 - 28 April 2017)

23 April 2017 Sunday:

 Arrival of the groups to their boarding house in Horšovský Týn (<u>http://www.parkur.eu/</u>), they speak English here. Unfortunately, Přimda is a small town and it is not possible to accommodate all your groups in a hotel in Přimda, so you'll stay in the town called Horšovský Týn which is about 35 km part from Přimda. You will travel by bus from Horšovský Týn to Přimda and back every day.

Monday:

- Leaving the hotel at 8:30
- Meeting at school and official welcome
- 9:30-10:30 Presentation and introducing of our school, country, our local area and our a-week-programme.
- 11:00-13:00 Workshop Ebru (Marbling). Marbling is a traditional painting style of our country. You can refer to YouTube for further details. At the beginning, we will introduce the art form and its history, then we will show how to make it. First, the teachers will do it, then students will be groups of 5 (one student from each country) and they will paint marbling pictures. Teachers and students can take their paintings after the programme.
- 13:10 Lunch at school
- For afternoon, Pottery Workshop at school)
- Dinner at the hotel

Tuesday:

- Leaving the hotels at 9 and arriving at the school
- 9:45 Start of Workshop Mosaics. We will introduce the making of mosaics first, then students will work in groups of 6, one/two students from each country. Students will prepare their country's mosaics flags on a pre-ready pattern model. (Our local area, Antakya, is famous for its archaeological mosaics remains and has a very rich history about it. It has a museum about it. We would like to prepare a nice picture, but making mosaics is hard and it needs a lot of time and professionalism to make a complex picture. So we chose flags, which is easier to make and can be finished in a shorter time. The patterns will be half-done, students will complete it.) At the same time, teachers will have a meeting to discuss about the next mobility. Emre and/or Ekrem (Eko) will supervise children during the meeting.
- 12:00 End of the workshop
- 12:00-13:00 Lunch at school
- 13:00 Visit of the famous spa Mariánské Lázně. There is a nice miniature park called Boheminium (<u>http://www.boheminium.cz/</u>) where you can see lots of famous Bohemian sights. Then we'll walk through the town along the promenade.

Wednesday:

- Leaving hotel at 08:30 and arriving at school
- 09:00-12:00 Workshop Cooking. Students will cook 6 different Turkish traditional dishes. Again one student from each country will participate. For each dish, one Turkish student will introduce the meal and cook it together with other students in his/her group. Teachers can also participate and watch or help cooking. Turkish teachers will supervise the students.
- 12:00 Lunch Students and teachers will eat the dishes they cooked.
- 13:15-14:45 Learning Turkish Folk Dances
- 14:45 FREE TIME IN HORŠOVSKÝ TÝN.
- Dinner at the hotel

<u>Thursday</u>

- Leaving hotels at 9:30 and arriving at the school
- 9:45-12:00 Workshop Folk dancing. Students will work together in the salon with music to learn some Turkish folk dances and "henna night" for wedding ceremony. Henna

night is a kind of celebration before the wedding ceremony and doing some decorations on bride's hands with henna during this celebration. Turkish teachers will supervise the students in turns.

- 13:00 students (or voluntary teachers together) will go swimming (entrance fee cannot be paid from the project budget. Students/teachers will pay from their own money.)
- Dinner at the hotel

Friday:

- Leaving hotels at 9:30 and arriving at the school
- 10:15 Exhibition of the products and giving them as presents to the countries (Marbling, Mosaics)
- 10:45 Performance of the learned folk dances.
- 11:00 Free time.
- 19:00 Closing dinner in Horšovský Týn and evaluation of the week. During the dinner time, students will perform the "henna night" dancing activity at the hotel. We hope, it will be so much fun.
