

“THE WOLF AND THE PUMPKIN” - SUGGESTED ACTIVITIES

1. ORAL RETELLING OF THE STORY “THE WOLF AND THE PUMPKIN”

Development of the activity: Using “THE WOLF AND THE PUMPKIN” story book, the teacher tells the story to the children.

2. GRAPHIC RECORD OF THE STORY

Development of the activity: The teacher gives each child an A4 sheet of paper where he/she will do the graphic record of the story.

3. LITERARY BASKET

Development of the activity: The teacher puts objects / the story’s characters (pumpkin, granny, wolf, etc.) in a basket. She allows the pupils to discover the objects, the pupils identify and associate them with their own experiences. Then, the teacher guides the children in the oral construction of a brief narrative that includes those objects.

4. MAKING MASKS TO ROLE-PLAY THE STORY

Development of the activity: The teacher provides various materials and each child uses them to make a mask of one of the story’s characters.

5. ROLE-PLAYING THE STORY

Development of the activity: With the teacher’s guidance, the children role-play the story, in small groups, using the masks they have made.

6. MAKING PUPPETS

Development of the activity: The teacher gives a wooden spoon to each child and puts several materials at their disposal. Fabrics, glue, coloured paper, wool, etc.). Each child makes a puppet of one of the story’s characters.

7. PUPPETS’ THEATRE

Development of the activity: In small groups the children role-play the story using the puppets they have made.

8. Maze

Development of the activity: Colour the path followed by the granddaughter to take the pumpkin to her granny.

9. Matching the number to the quantity

Development of the activity: Match the quantity of pumpkins with their respective number.

10. Cooking activity: Making pumpkin jam

Development of the activity: The teacher asks the children to bring some pumpkin to the kindergarten.

Preparation:

- 1 kg of pumpkin cut into cubes
- 800 gr of sugar
- orange peel
- 1 cinnamon stick

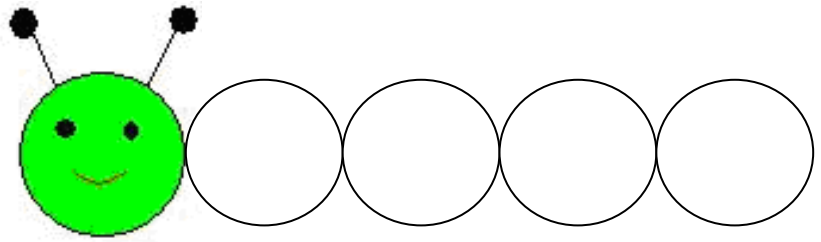
1. Put the pumpkin, the sugar, the cinnamon stick and the orange peel in a pot, mix, put the lid on it and leave it to simmer. To check if it is ready, put a small portion of the jam in a plate and try to divide it into two separate parts with the help of a spoon. When both parts don't mix and are well divided, the jam is ready.

2. Then put the jam into jars.
Each child can take a jar home.

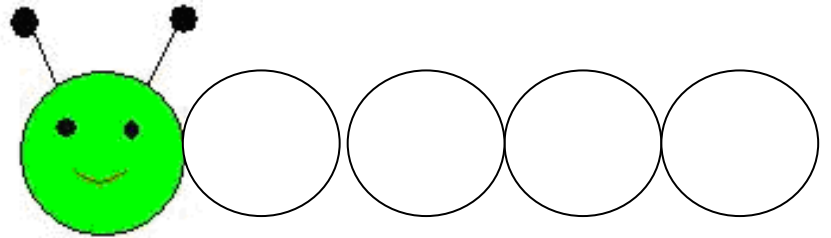
PICK THE NUMBER OF BODY CIRCLES OF THE CORRESPONDING LIZARD
THE NUMBER OF SYLLABLES OF EACH WORD



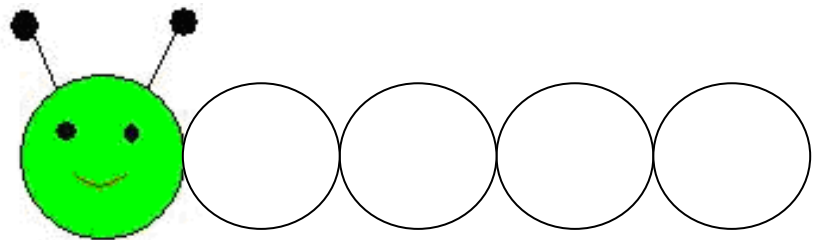

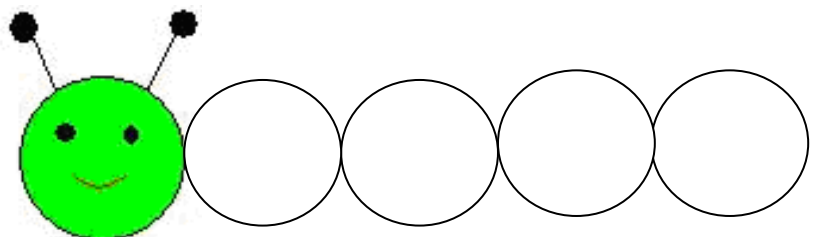

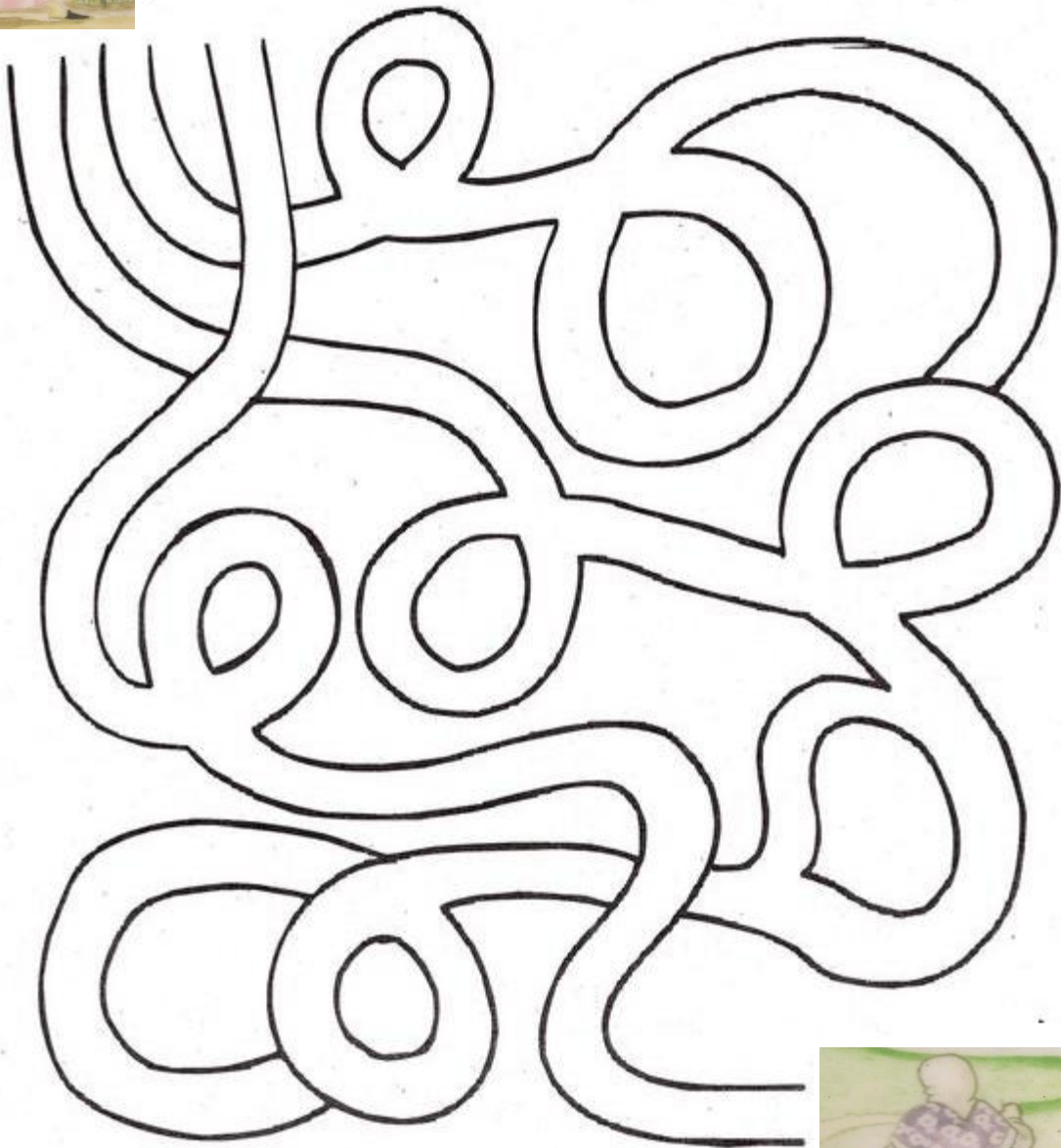
