This programming of the European Project "WORKING TOGETHER IS EASIER" (Working together is easier) is the second part of the project framed through the action program in the field of lifelong learning for 2014-2015 eTwinning course initiated and carried out in the middle.

Based on the programming done the previous year, the results obtained along the courses, the quarterly assessments, the report by the professionals involved and the proposed improvements contained in these reports, it was decided, at the end of the previous year, continue during the current academic year (2015-2016), but ending the project and starting a new one.

To carry out and develop programming that will guide the project have been followed maintained continuously, communication (via email) with the other founder of the Project, which have allowed (depending on what worked previously) mark guidelines work along each of the quarters.

During the different months they have conducted communications professionals who have allowed adjusting activities in considering the timing semester of each country as well as the different holidays of each country. Likewise, we have provided various festivals that take place in the center which will allow the shaft to be performing some activities.

Through the project, we intend to further improve our communication skills with students with special educational needs which will continue to use various methods and communication tools such as: video, audio, photography, cartoons, text, pictograms, .. and not only focus is aspects such as spoken communication or reading.

The areas that involve the development of it are varied: Geography, Art, Natural Sciences, Special Education, European Studies, History of Culture, Information Technology, ICT, Language and Literature, Media, Music, Theater, ...

With students used the Castilian although the teachers shall translate English productions to communicate between the two countries (to the students the information they give is always translated into Castilian).

This year we will try (to the extent possible) to create more autonomous students in TwinSpace user accounts as they are able to translate their messages using online translators to communicate with students from another center.

As for the main objectives of the project are: the acquisition and development of skills and abilities to use fluently different media it motivating to students. Daily Project will take place in TwinSpace but other platforms will also be used to house productions as Padlet.

Although we are aware that the programming may be subject to change depending on student motivation, the incorporation of new issues because of their needs, to the request for it by students and professionals, the activities will be planned quarterly and will included in the programming and the location thereof. Therefore, only at the end of the course they can write the different activities, the results of each of them, the resources used, times, evaluating them ..

The results will pretend always be the improvement of skills, abilities, improvements in computer communication, improved motivation for school work, motivation for professionals involved schools and other centers to participate in European projects.

The resources we use are all those with whom the Centre has: staffroom with the PDI, computer room, classroom, home, garden, patio, environment, ... printers, network connections, webcam, camera, scanner, materials expendable ...

The families of the students involved will be informed at all times of the activities undertaken for their children which, of course start will be informed of their children's participation in the project and its operation. Also, different activities will be posted on the Blog Center (cpeelaquinta.blogspot.com.es) considering the right image of each of the students by the Act applicable data protection in our country and the signed authorizations by parents / legal for each guardian.

Bearing in mind the existing quarterly assessments and collections in different documents Center, students belonging to the European Projects: eTwinning will be evaluated quarterly based on the objectives, content and evaluation criteria programmed for each of the quarters and will be prepared a newsletter evaluation will be attached to quarterly newsletter in the relevant field (Scope of social and community integration).

As reflected in the PGA and therefore points in the CCP day of the academic year 2015-2016, European Projects will be evaluated and reported to the professionals of the Center on the dates set for it.
