## HOW TO PLAY BOLICHES?

## In groups of 6 or 7 students.

A circle is drawn on the ground and inside each player places a boliche.

From a line about 2 meters away, the players, in order, throw their bowling boliches, trying to hit those in the circle. If they manage to hit one and get it out, they keep it.

The next participant throws, performing the same action, or you can choose to try to hit bowling boliches from those who have previously thrown. If it hits one, the owner of the latter will be forced to return the bowling boliches won to
their owners and will be eliminated from the game.
The game ends when there are no boliches left in the circle.

## RULES OF "BOLICHES"

Turns: the specific order in which you play in depends o the player Space: you will have to draw a circle with chalk on the ground

Boliches: since there are lots of kinds of boliches (big, small,made of mud, crystal...) you will have to choose a kind to play with)

Stealing: you must decide if the player who got the boliches out of the circle is allowed to keep them or to put them aside.
