

Is Estonia the smallest country in the world?

· No it is not:)

Population: 1.3 million inhabitants

Area: 45 227 km²



 But we like to say that everything here is small:

- Largest town Tallinn (capital city) has 400 000 inhabitants.
- The highest point of Estonia is Suur Munamägi (BIG EGG HILL)
 only 318 meters high
 (The best reaction I have got to it: "It is like a swamp!").



What language do we speak? Eesti keelt (=Estonian language)

• Estonian is the official language of Estonia, spoken by about 1.1 million people in Estonia and tens of thousands in various emigre communities in Sweden, USA, United Kingdom, Australia.



Is it difficult to learn it? Yes!

- Estonian is one of the most beautiful languages in the world but it is also a really complicated language to learn.
- Estonian language has the vowel " \tilde{O} ". We have also letters \ddot{A} , \ddot{O} , \ddot{U} .








Pärnu – seaside resort

Estonia has over 1500 islands, 3700 km-s of coastline




The biggest island is Saaremaa (The Isle of Land) (2672 km²)

If you want to


- try "blood sausages"

it is the fifth largest lake in Europe with a total area of 3555 square km (it forms the border with Russia)






About our history

- · Before the 13th century there were Estonian leaders
- Estonia has been under the rule of Danes, Germans, Swedes and Russians
- · Independence was declared on 24th February 1918
- Soviet occupation 1940-1991 (German 1941-44)
- · Independence was restored on 20 August 1991
- · Joined NATO and the European Union in 2004




What do we like to say?

What is e-Estonia?

- 84.5% of Estonian people use the Internet (India 7%, Ukraine 42%, Austria 74%, Sweden 92% of the population)
- Almost all of Estonian people have a computer at home, many families have several.
- Every Estonian school is connected to the internet and they participate in the e-school program
- · There are a lot of FREE Wifi hotspots
- Income tax declaration can be filled in the Internet, it takes a short time
- You can vote for elections through the internet, buy tickets and goods



More Facts

- Estonia was the developer of Skype, Kazaa and Hotmail.
- We have a lot of IT companies
- Estonian scientists are collecting genes
 of the population to make genetical
 researches (on diseases and gene therapy)
- Scientists are working to discover vaccine for HIV
- We produce electricity (oil shale mines)

· No poisonous spiders




