OVERVIEW

The project focuses on life, personality and creative works on one of the most famous Lithuanian artists Mikalojus Konstantinas Čiurlionis and encourages students to look at his life and creativity in a non-stereotypic way.

TEACHING AIMS

- To present students new ideas about Mikalojus Konstantinas Čiurlionis life and creativity.
- To familiarize students with websites dedicated to Mikalojus Konstantinas Čiurlionis life and creativity.
- To develop and enhance students' IT skills working on creating project presentation with different interactive presentation tools (PowerPoint, Prezi and etc.)
- To foster students individual work skills by selecting, compiling, sourcing information, creating, initiating and developing individual presentations.

PROJECT WORK STRUCTURE

LESSON STEPS

- During the introductory lesson a teacher tries to find out what the students know about Mikalojus Konstantinas Čiurlionis so far.
- The teacher then introduces the topic of the project “The World as a Symphony” and invites students to try to look at the life and creative work of the artist from a different angle.
- The teacher elicits and proposes different topics for the future projects:
 - M.K. Čiurlionis and Druskininkai
 - M.K. Čiurlionis and Sofia
 - M.K. Čiurlionis and letters
 - M.K. Čiurlionis and nature
 - M.K. Čiurlionis and friends
 - M.K. Čiurlionis and music
 - M.K. Čiurlionis in photography
 - M.K. Čiurlionis and his paintings “The Zodiac Cycle”
 - M.K. Čiurlionis and his paintings “The Creation of the World”
- The teacher encourages each student to select a project topic regarding one’s personal interests, inner feelings and emotional state.
- Then the teacher gives the students the list of internet websites which students can explore and look for relevant to their project topic information:

- Next, students work individually: they make selection of information, visual images, information, analyze, interpret it and afterwards produce a multimedia presentation.
- The teacher monitors students work and acts as a mentor, consultant helping the students to develop their projects.
- The teacher also acts as a technical consultant assisting students working on their multimedia presentations.

ASSESSMENT CRITERIA

THE TEACHER EVALUATES:

- the depth of the deliverance of topics on M.K. Čiurlionis life and creativity
- the understanding of the chosen topic
- the vocabulary related to the subject matter and key words
- the production of a multimedia presentation
- the structure and content of a multimedia presentation and how it is related to the main topic of the project “The World as a Symphony”
- the creative part of the project work
