

## **MARBLING**

Marbling is the art of creating colorful patterns by sprinkling and brushing color pigments on a pan of oily water and then transforming this pattern to paper. The special tools of the trade are brushes of horsehair bound to straight rose twigs, a deep tray made of unknotted pinewood, natural earth pigments, cattle gall and tragacanth.





















## **RIBBON FLOWER**

# Things needed:

Satin ribbon 5/8 inch width, scissors, needle and thread, glue gun or any other super glue, buttons - pearl - rhine stones ...for the centre Hold the ribbon with your thumb. Make loops of equal length. Pass your needle either on the left or right edge (not in the centre). Make sure that the needle is passed through all layers. Tie some knots to secure it. Trim off the extra thread. Open all loops to form flowers shape. Use some glue to stick the center of your choice


Girl with flower Crown 2013, by Elena Riera Material: HB2 pencil, paper Made in 2013

Paper Flowers


I love flowers. They are so beautiful but they do not last very long because they fade easily. To keep them "fresh" for a long time you can create some flowers from cardboard patterned paper.




Step 1 Start with the patterned side of your paper face down. Fold the bottom corner of your paper up to the top to make a triangle.




Step 2 Fold the left and the right corners to the middle to make a square.



Step 3 Fold the left and right point so the folded line is even with the outside edge of the square.



Step 4 Flatten the flaps you have created.




Step 5 Fold the top triangles down.



Step 6 Fold the large triangles back using your earlier crease. Glue the outside triangles together.



Step 7 Repeat four times so you have five petals in all. These petals will be connected to formy paper flower.



Step 8 Glue your petals together to make the finished flower.
