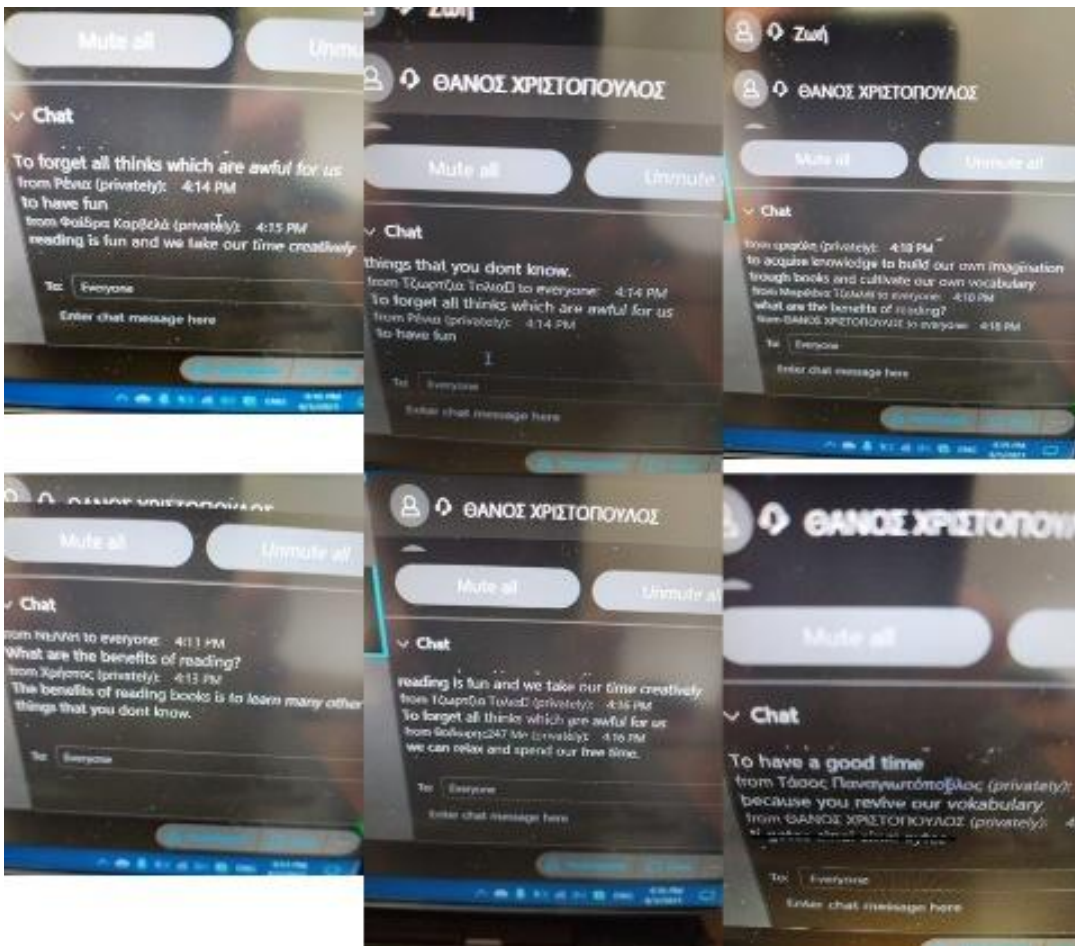

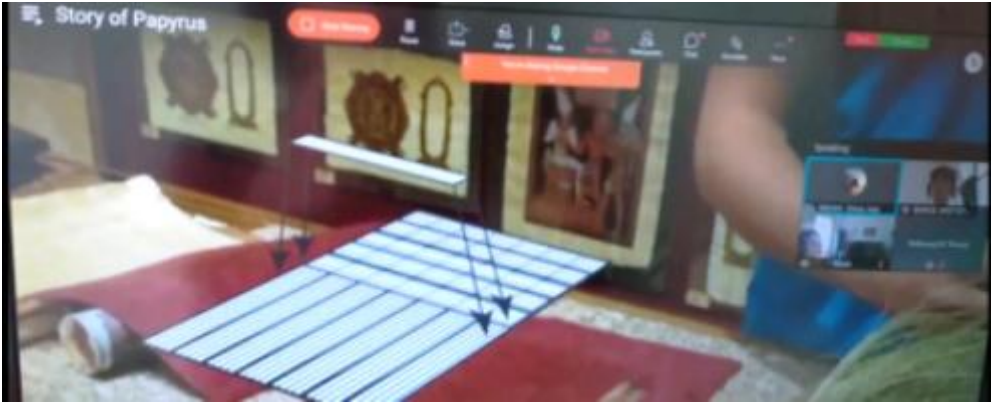

In my opinion it is one of the most interesting books because it makes observations about life and human nature.

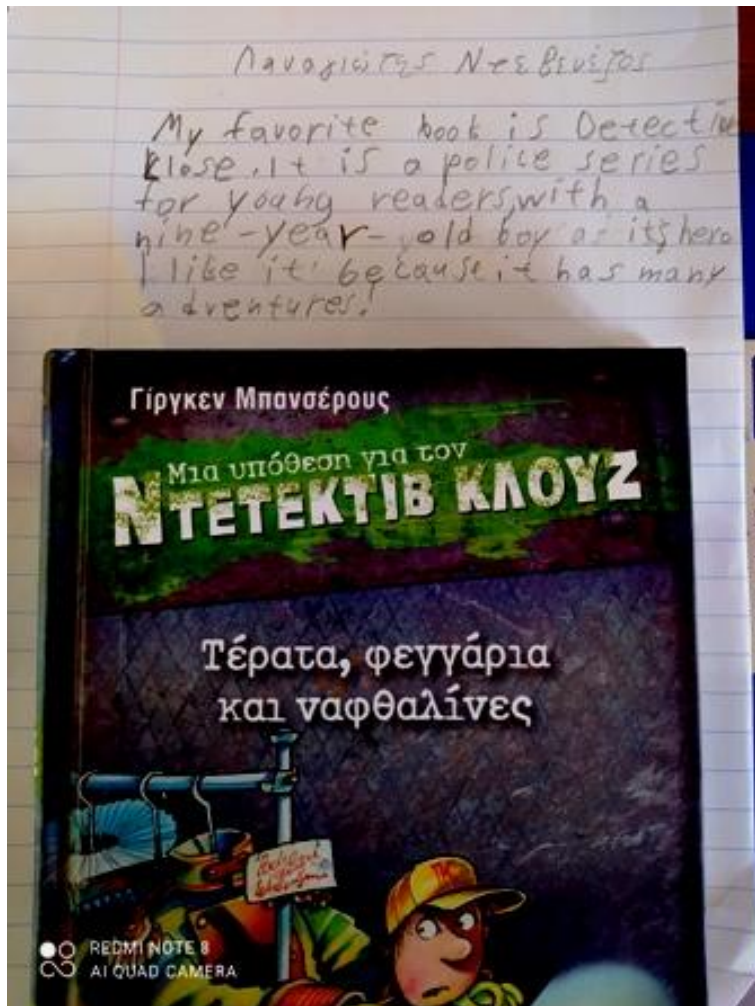
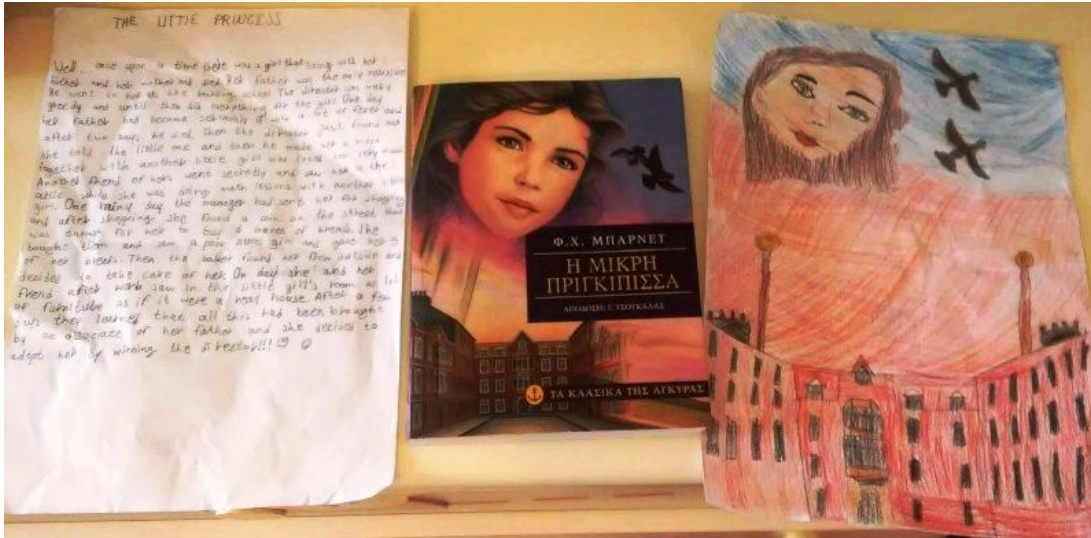
I would suggest you read it.
