The project


AD-DICTED TO EDUCATION is an Erasmus+ KA2 project developed by 6 schools in Poland, Greece, Croatia, Romania, Spain and Italy. This project **promotes equality, non-discrimination and inclusion** among all pupils; the acquisition of basic skills **to make critical and responsible decisions in their consumer actions**; the development of **language skills** (English, French and Spanish) and **the use of information and communication technologies** in a collaborative way. The **European Cultural Heritage** will be also publicized and the participating schools will develop their internationalisation.

The project will be carried out over two school years and the activities will be focused on advertising during the first year, in addition to working on values such as **equality and non-discrimination** by leaving knowledge of the Cultural Heritage of the partner countries for the second year. All this will be developed through different activities: workshops, reflections, oral presentations, information search, viewing of announcements, visits among the partner centres, training courses, use of digital tools. Through this newsletter we will inform you about all these activities.

1st mobility, Training event

Sopot, Poland, November 20th -22nd 2019

16 teachers from 6 partner countries met in the Polish school. We were solemnly welcomed by our Polish coordinator, Aleksandra Rafflewski, and the headmaster and we were enjoying some songs and dances performed by the youngest pupils. During 3 days we introduced ourselves, discussed the details of the project, got familiar with the eTwinning platform and TwinSpace as well as did a cultural tour around Sopot and the neighbouring cities Gdansk and Gdynia. It was a great opportunity for our professional development in a friendly surrounding.

The main aim of the mobility was the **training of the teachers on eTwinning**.

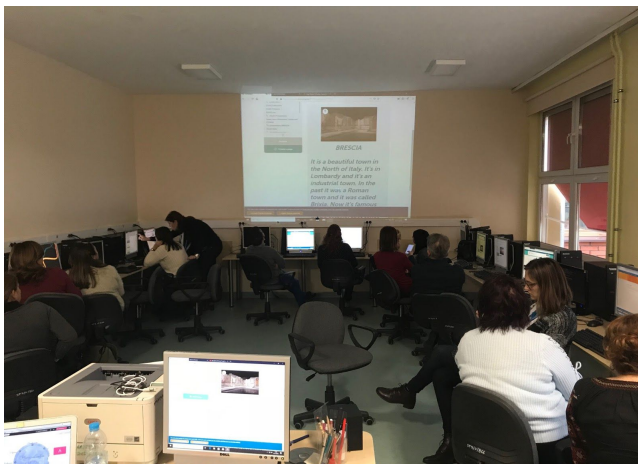


- What is eTwinning?, eTwinning live: profile, forums, groups and events.

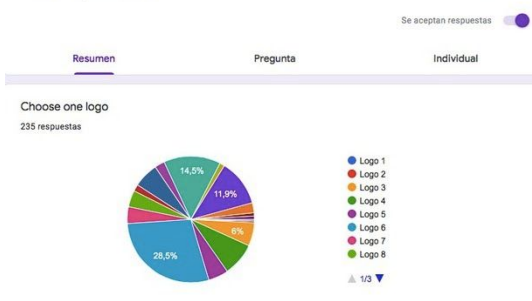
Working with students

We have done different activities with students:

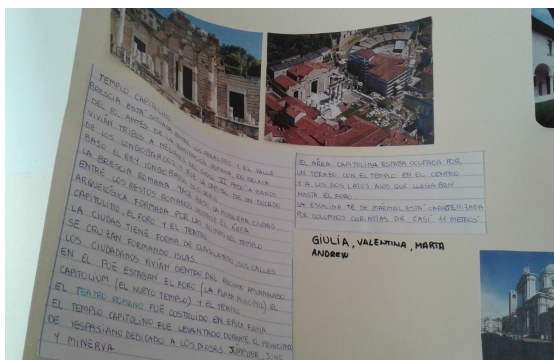
- Introduction of the countries to the students through **videos and presentations**. We shared them in the Twinspace.

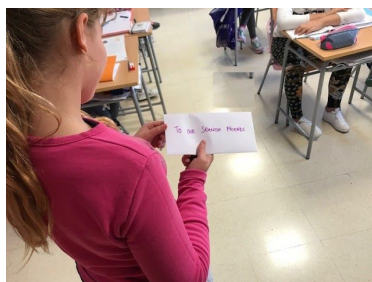
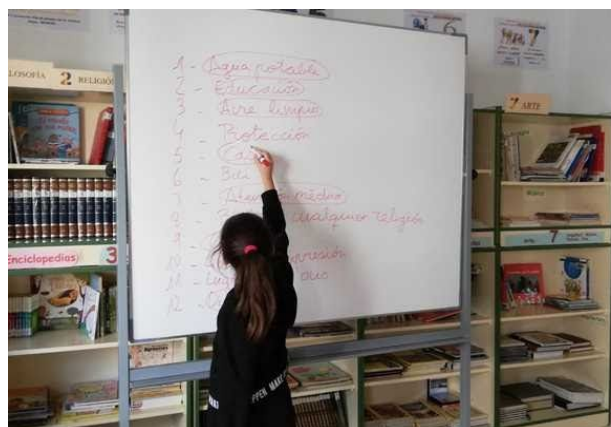

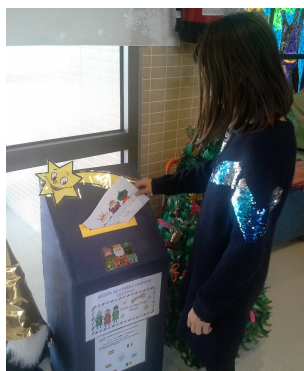
We worked **responsible consumption** in Pre-Primary with tales.
