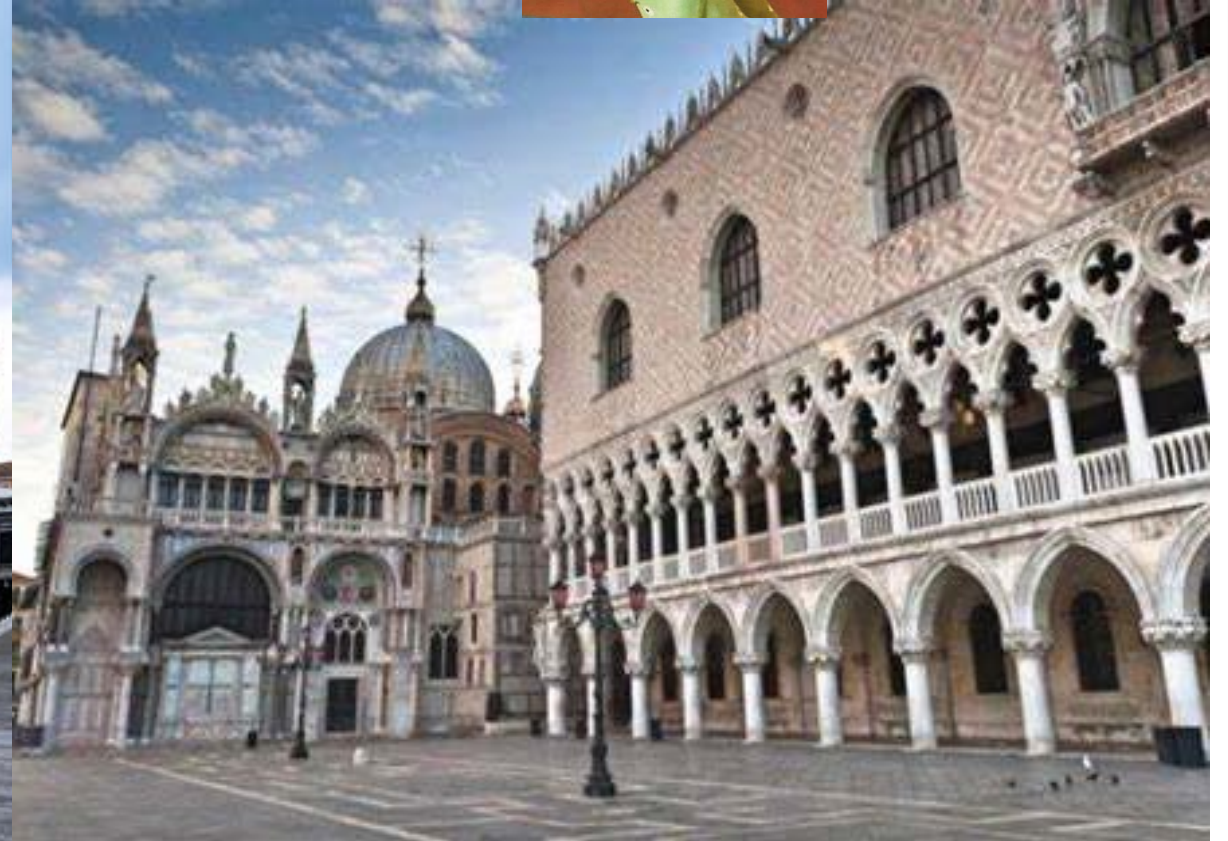

Gold Staircase !

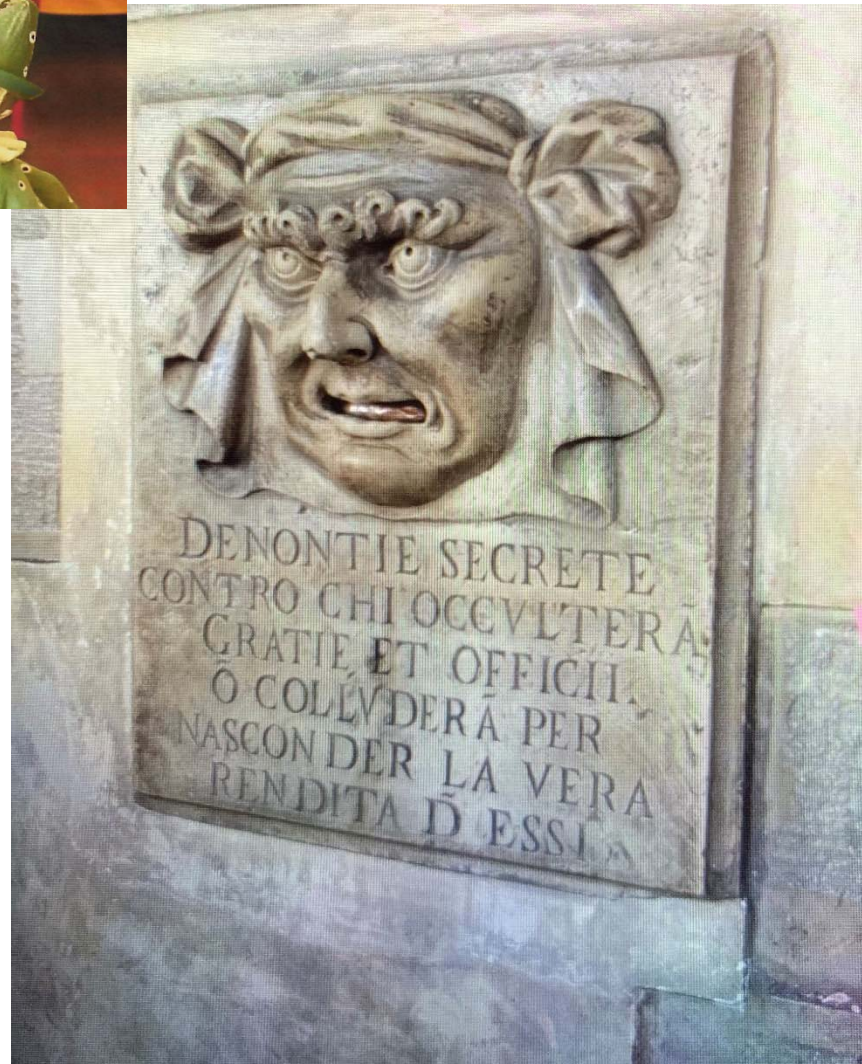
The ceiling is decorated with

The one of Marin Faliero, a traitor, is covered with a black cloth.



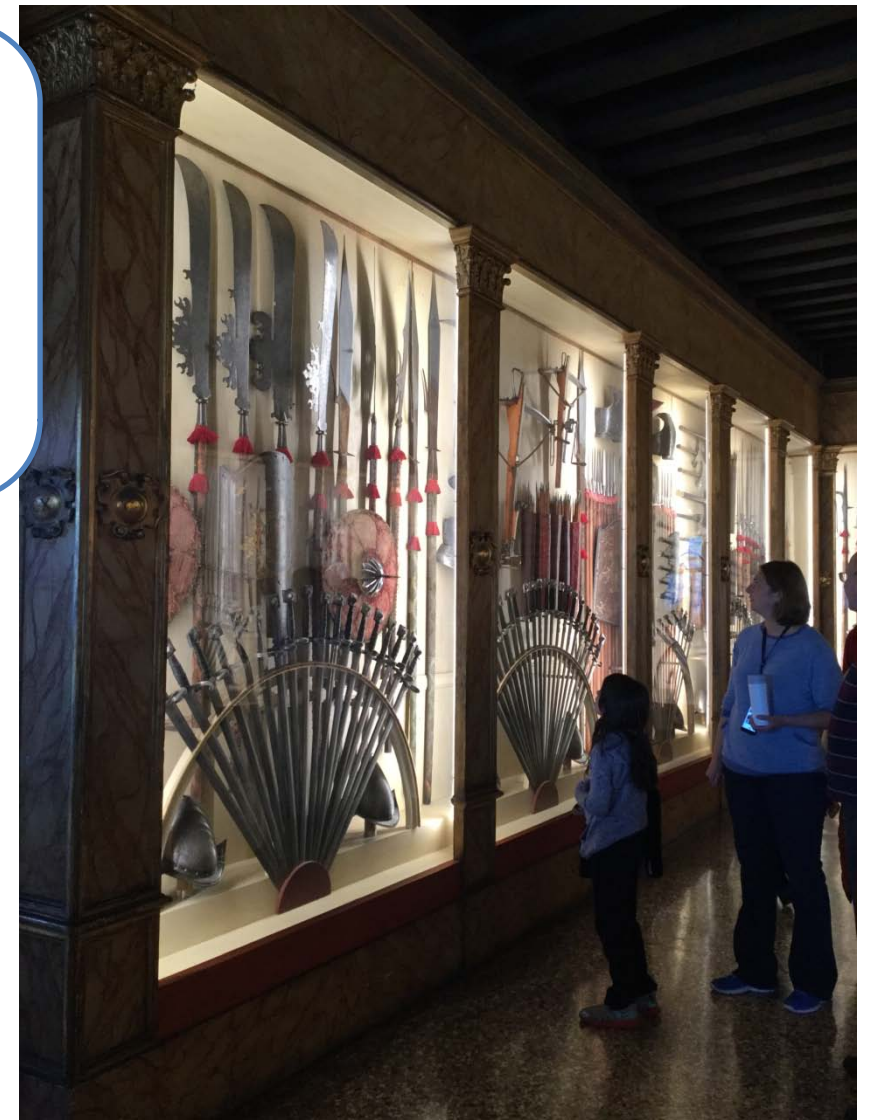
Here you can see one of the biggest paintings in the world: «The paradise» by Tintoretto

spoils of war.





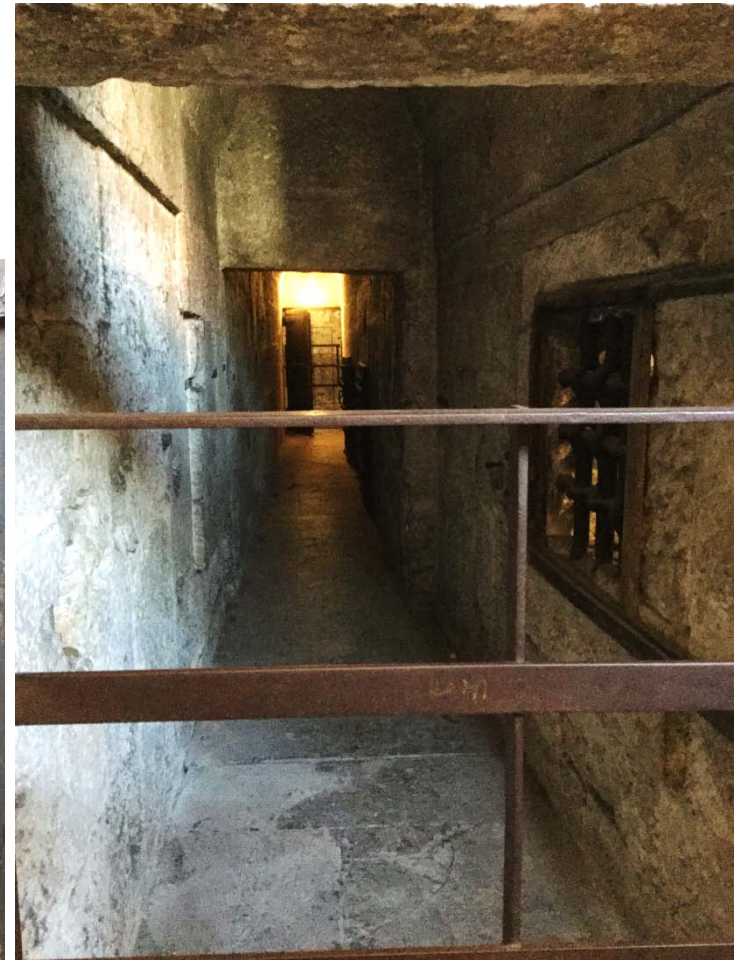
THE BRIDGE OF SIGHS
