Our European Museums Tour Project Analysis of Students' Survey (2020)






## **Overall Results**

#### A large number of students liked the Project.


More than half of the students liked project tasks and developed themselves. Most of them said they want to take part in an E-twinning Project again.

### How old are you? (185 answers)




42.7% of the students are between 12-15 years old and 57.3% of the students are between 9-11 years old.

# Had you already participated to E-Twinning Projects? (185 answers)




Most of the students had already participated to E-twinning Projects before. 9,7% of the students had never participated to a Project before.

#### What did you like most? (185 answers)







#### Did you improve your language skills? (185 answers)




16,2% of the students thought that their English improved a little bit. 25,9% of the students thought that their English improved enough. Most of the students thought their English really improved. Like all of the Etwinning projects, our Project has also helped our students' English.

#### Did you develop your IT skills? (185 answers)





#### When did you visit the TwinSpace? (185 answers)




