Ducal Castle Museum

at Corigliano-Rossano

It arose as a military fortress in 1073 and over time has undergone a series of transformations. The Sanseverino princes, the Saluzzo dukes and the Compagna barons changed and expanded its original structure to make it impregnable to enemy sieges and subsequently adapt it to a noble residence.





National Museum of Sibaritide at Sibari

The archaeological museum is a museum-like structure that exhibits artifacts from the ancient period, generally including finds from prehistory to the classical age, although it often includes productions up to the end of the eighteenth century and sometimes even beyond.

Diocesan Museum at Corigliano Rossano



The Diocesan and Codex Museum is a Calabrian museum. It is located in Rossano, in the municipality of Corigliano-Rossano, in the province of Cosenza, next to the Cathedral of the Santissima Achiropita. Inside, the museum houses its main work: the Codex Purpureus Rossanensis, an illuminated gospel book written in ancient

Greek of the sixth century, concerning the New Testament, included in the

UNESCO heritage lists in the "Memory of the Word" category on October 9, 2015. According to many, it is the oldest illustrated Gospel in the world.

The museum also preserves about two hundred works of art from various eras and of various nature that belonged to different churches of the archdiocese of Rossano-Cariati.
