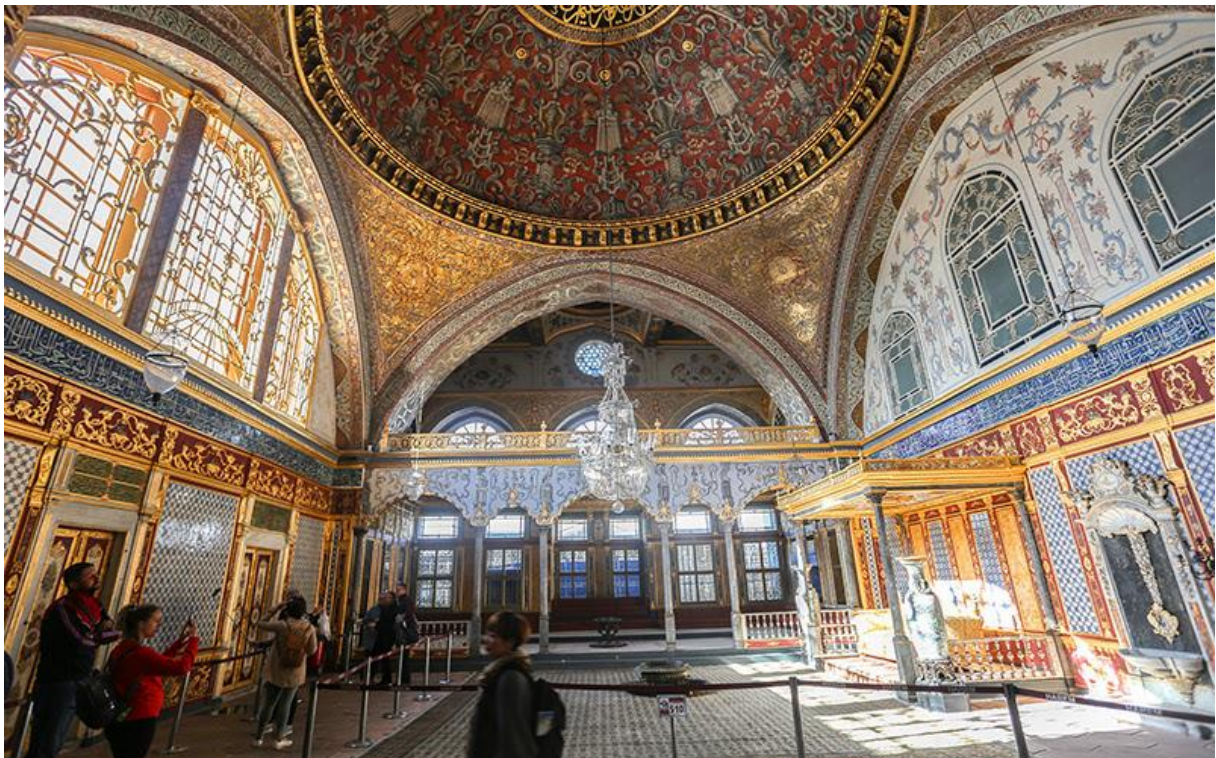


1. Topkapı Palace Museum, Istanbul

Topkapı Palace Museum is the most magnificent structure of Sarayburnu, located at the extreme point of the Historic Peninsula between the Bosphorus, the Marmara Sea and the Golden Horn. Topkapı Palace, which has been used as the administrative, education and art center of the Ottoman Empire for 400 years, is a place where the city breathes with its historical texture and collections as well as its garden covered with trees that challenge the time.

It converted into a museum in 1924 and today Turkey's most visited museums of Topkapı Palace Museum, 2018 2 million 980 thousand 450 people had guests. In the museum, Harem and Zülüflü Baltacılar Ward, Hagia Irene Museum, Harem, Divan-ı Hümayun, Bağdat Mansion, Revan Mansion, Sofa Mansion and III. There are sections such as Ahmet Library and Sacred Relics Department.



2. Ayasofya, Istanbul

Hagia Sophia, which was built by Emperor Justinianos to the famous architects of the period, Anthemios of Tralles and Isidoros of Miletos and used as a church for 916 years, is one of the most important structures in the world in terms of art and architectural history.

Hagia Sophia, known as the eighth wonder of the world today and converted into a mosque after Fatih Sultan Mehmet conquered Istanbul, has been serving as a museum since 1935. With a magnificent view of Istanbul as well as one of Turkey's most visited museum Hagia Sophia, a landmark of the historical peninsula.
