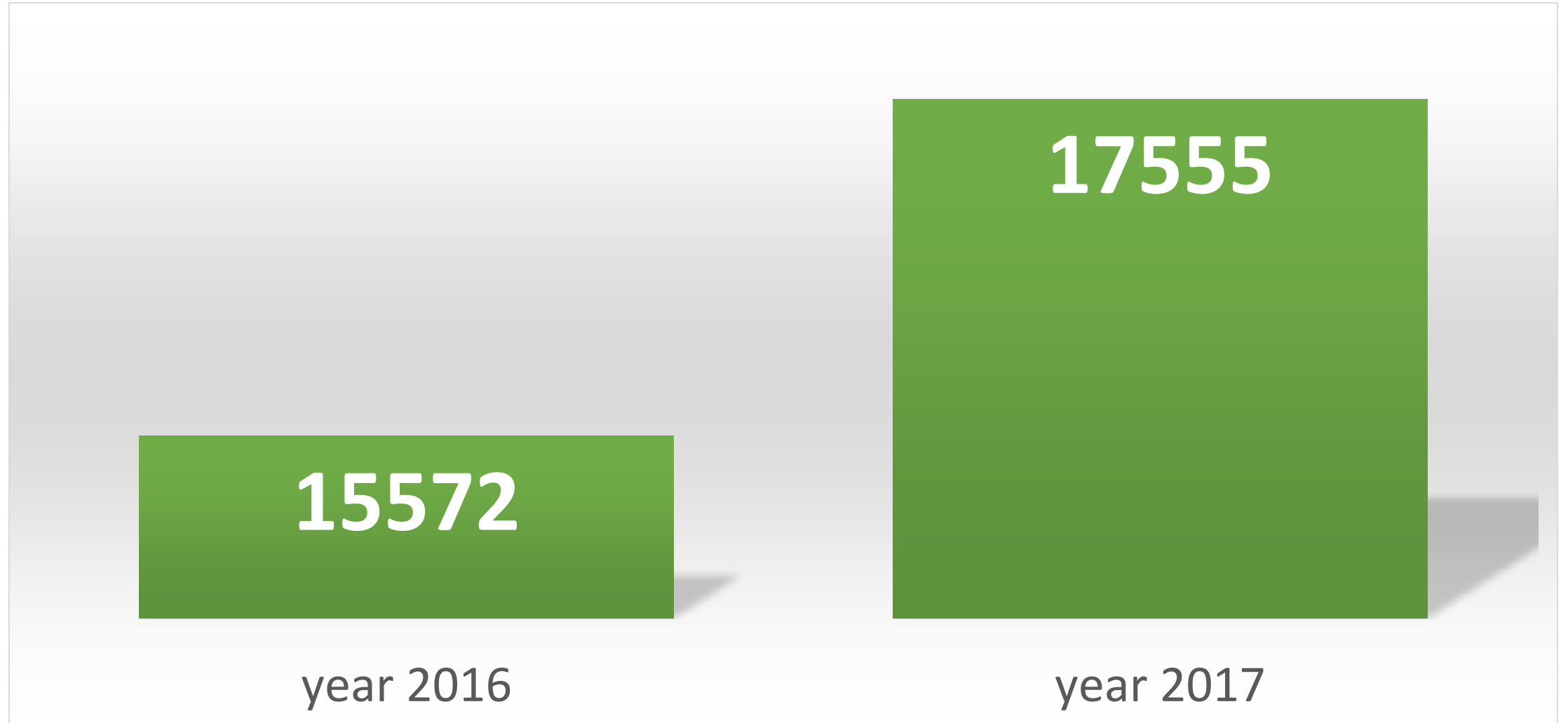

VISA REGIMES AND VISAS

- Visa regime applied in Slovenia is a part of EU aquis
- Visa countries
- Non-visa countries
- Meet the requirements that are prescribed by the laws.



VISAS

- Type C - a permission to enter the country (up to 90 days)
- Type D - a permission to enter and stay in the country (more than 90 days and less than one year)



How do I apply for a visa?

- Submit the application in person at a diplomatic mission
- All ten fingerprints



Where can I obtain visa application forms?

- Available at all diplomatic missions
- The travel document - three months

What are a third-country national's obligations after arriving in Slovenia?

- Register their residence – 3 days
- A hotel, camp or any other similar facility

ONLY 3 DAYS

EEA CITIZENS AND SWISS NATIONALS

- Identity card
- Passport
- Visa
- Residence permit



THIRD-COUNTRY NATIONALS

- a visa before entering the country
- Or
 - type C visa
 - residence permit
 - long-stay visa (type D)



RESIDENCE PERMIT

- To enter and stay for a specified time and a specified purpose.
- The 1st resident permit is a single permit and it is only temporary.
- It must be acquired before entering the country.

TYPES OF RESIDENCE PERMIT

- temporary residence permit:
(not more than one year)
- permanent residence permit

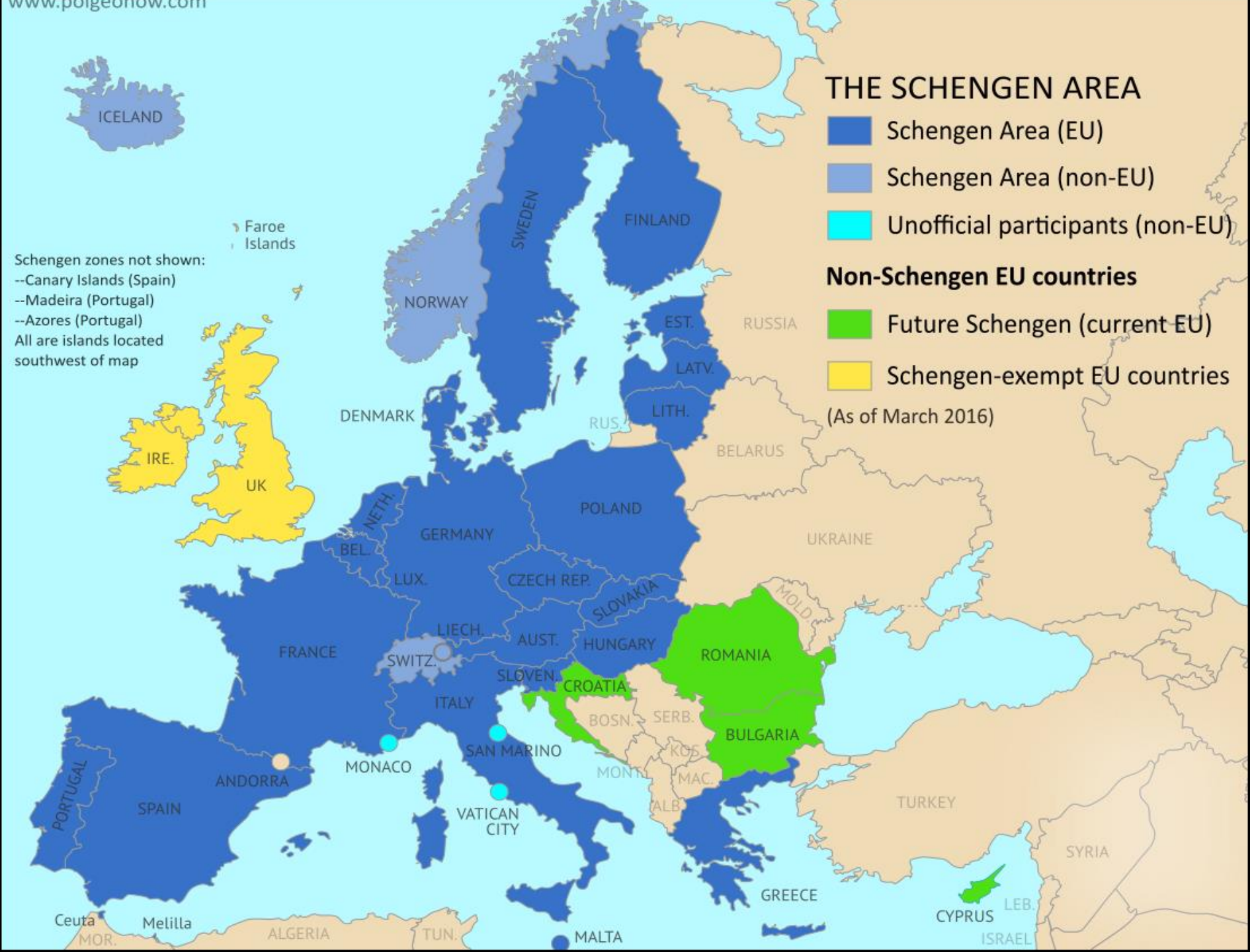

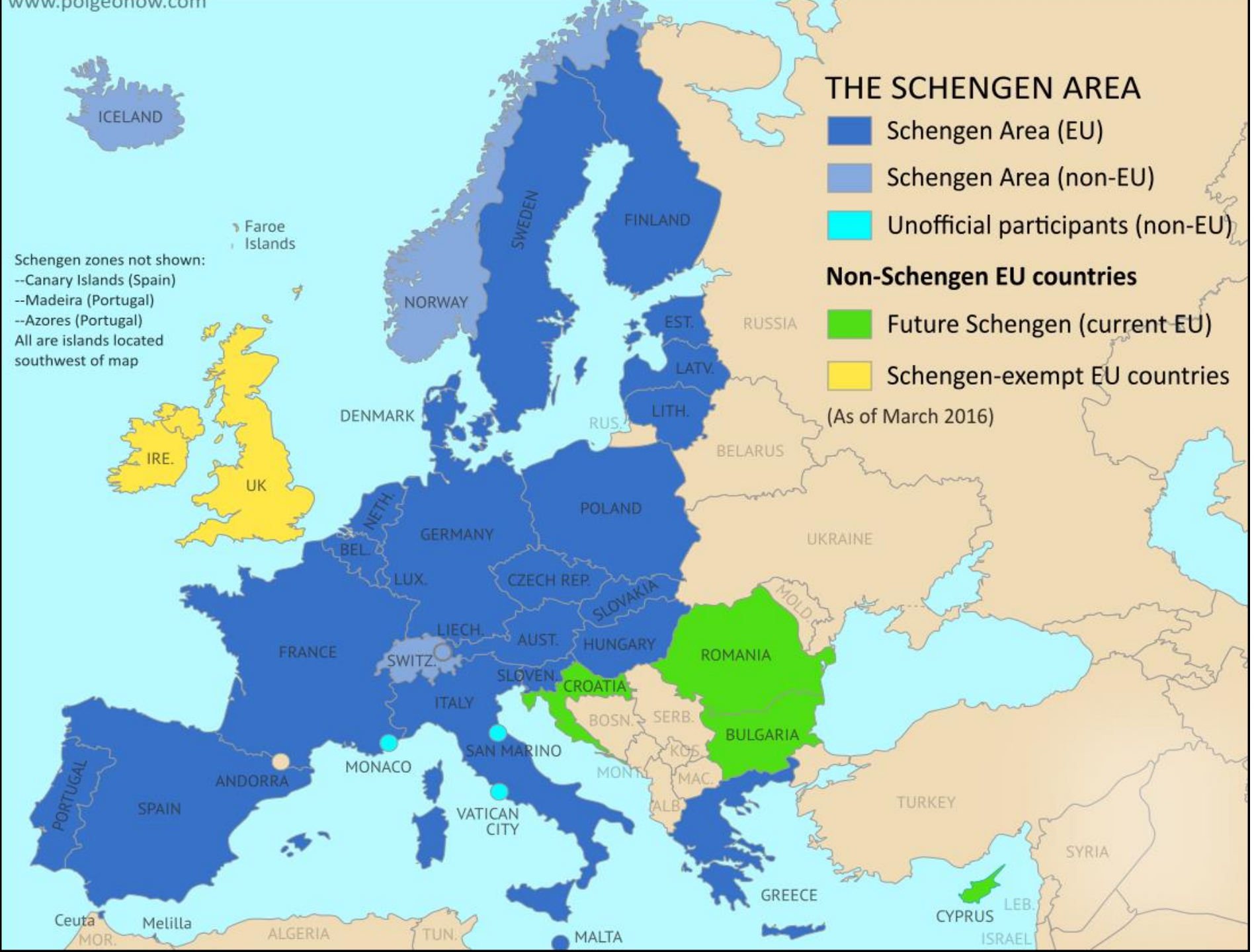

At the external border ...

... EU nationals generally undergo minimum checks to verify their identities on the basis of travel documents.

... non-EU nationals must present a valid travel document and a visa, if required, or a residence permit, as well as documents that justify the purpose of their stay and prove that they possess sufficient financial resources to support themselves during their stay.

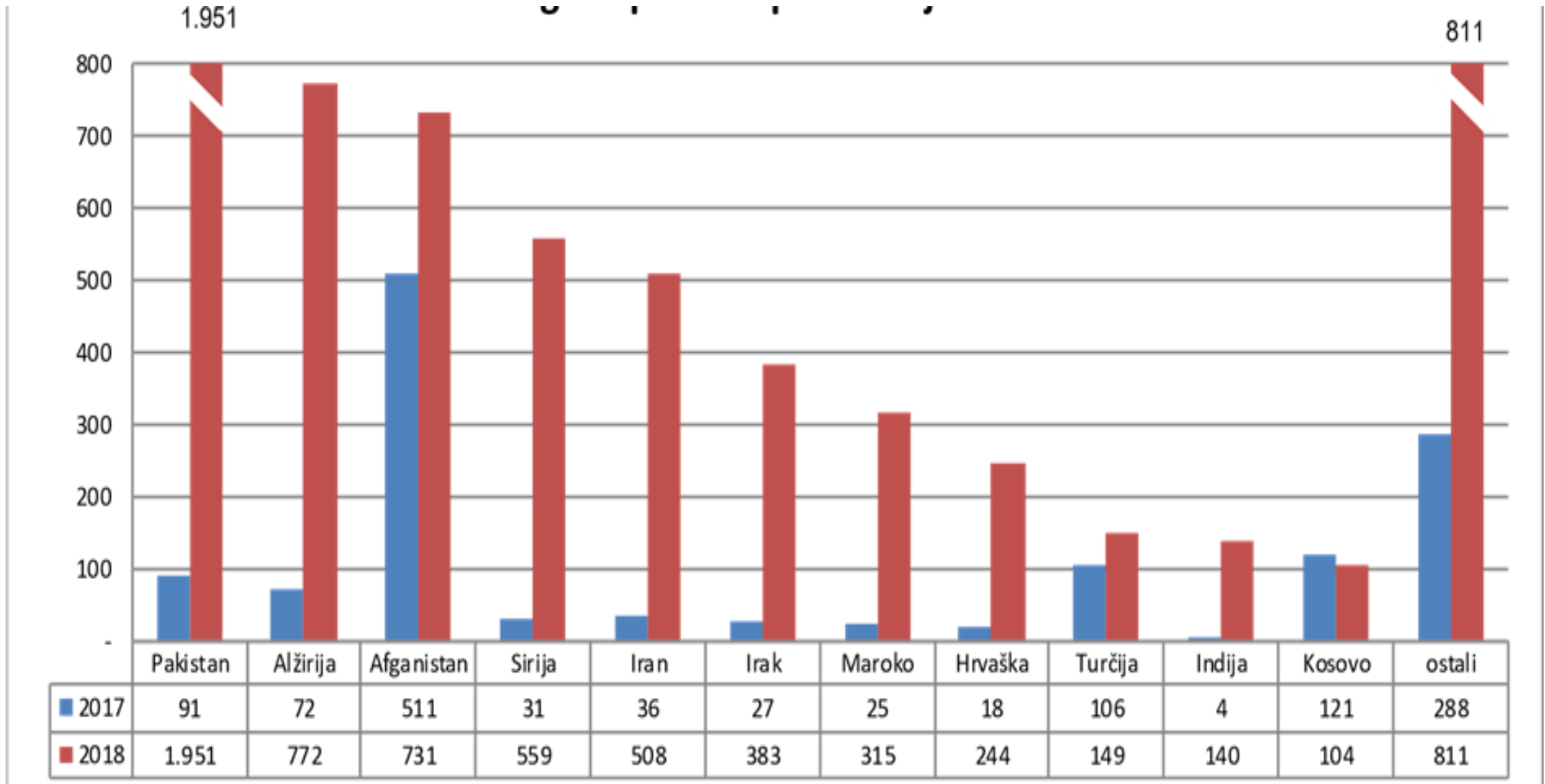

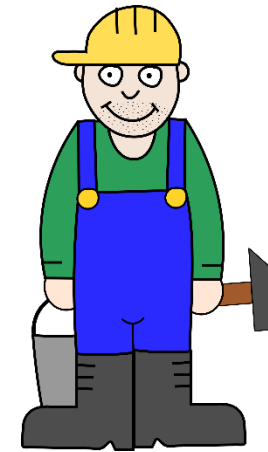
