# AYIOS DOMETIOS III ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

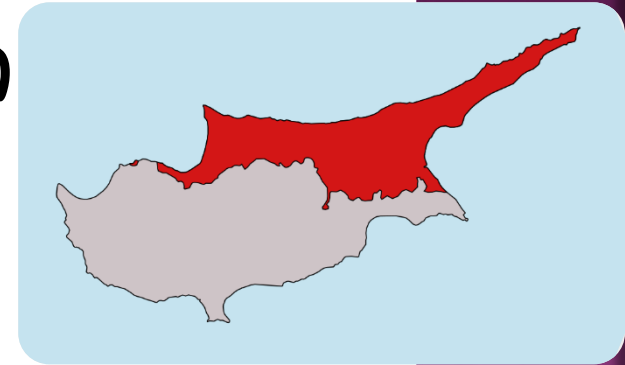
Two important dates:

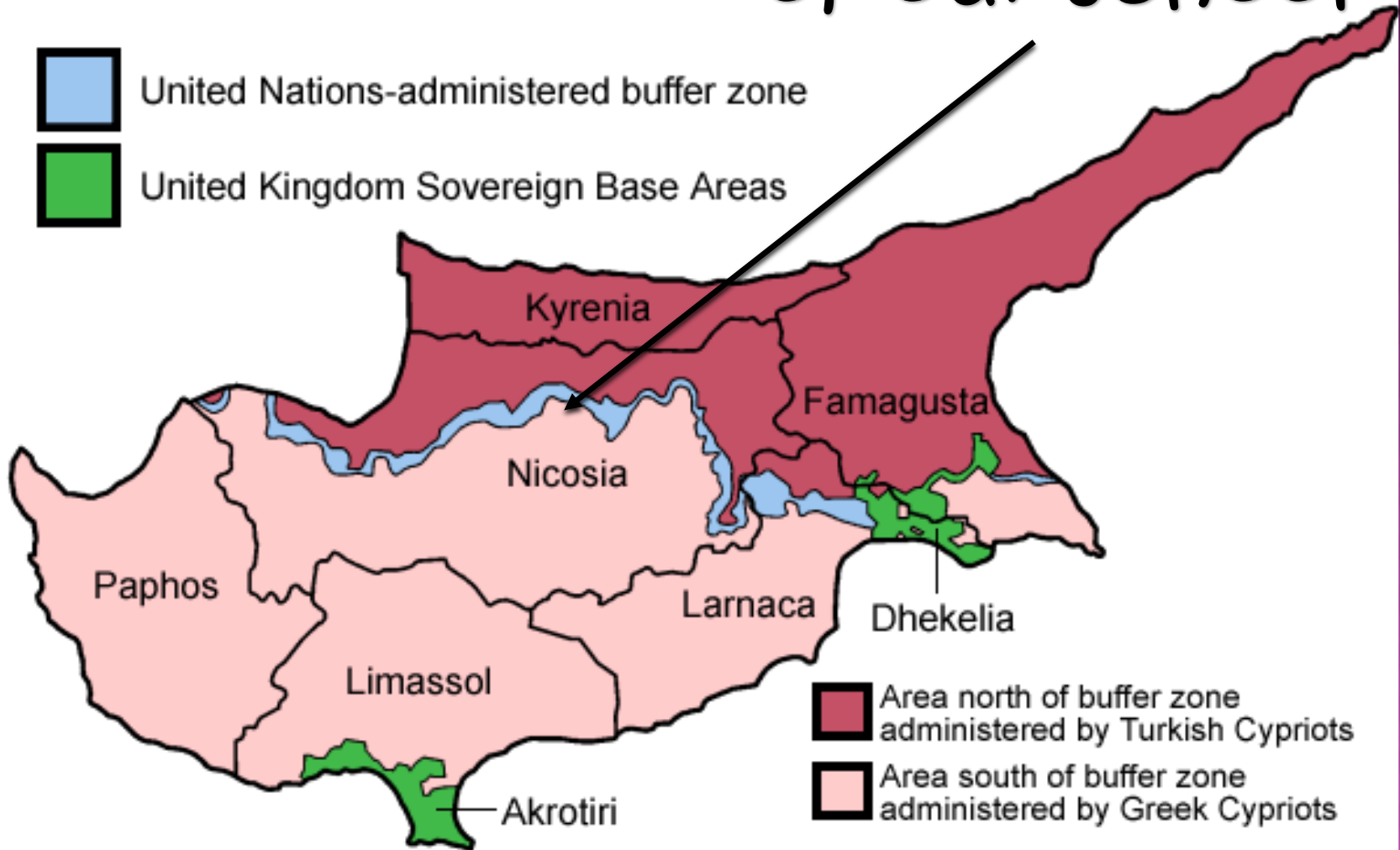
