







Family Day: We invited the parents and the grandparents to our school to talk to us about their country or village and share with us stories from their childhood.
















Parents came to our school and played with the children traditional games of Cyprus. They also prepared food and ate with the children and the teachers.





Charity Bazaars are organized by the students' council. Children brought their used toys and books to the bazars.








