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Mirror Mirror on the Wall – second transnational meeting
Oulu, Finland March 19th-25th, 2018

Welcome to the 2nd transnational meeting to Oulu, Finland.
Preliminary schedule:

Mon March, 19th

9.00 am. The school of Jääli. Welcome to the school of Jääli. Pupils from Greece and Cyprus work integrated from 9 am. to 2 pm. in the classes and get to know each others. Pupils create a cultural portfolio about Oulu and Jääli.

Later in the evening, around 4.30 pm as the German team has arrived, an opening meeting, where the participants meet and get to know each others.

German pupils travel to Finnish homes for accommodation. German pupils complete to their portfolios by exploring Finnish culture, interviewing their host families and creating a cultural portfolio.

Tue March, 20th

9.00 am. Getting to know each others continues. Pupils spent the entire day (9 am-2pm) integrated in the classrooms (PE, music, art, English) where they learn through plays and games.

11am. Lunch

Teachers have a meeting (from 10 am.) and start discussing project timetable, eTwinning, handbook, evaluation questionnaire and the results, project report, Skype meetings and letters, Ecas Mobility tool and storybook.

2 pm.: Exploring the Finnish nature and its' specialities. Comparing and doing research together on features of the nature of each partner country. Pupils collect material for their portfolio.

Wed March, 21st

9.00 am. The school of Jääli.

9am-11am: Presentations of the partner schools in the gym hall for the entire school. Selection of the winner of "I am proud of my family" -competition.

11 am. lunch

12 pm. A joined project: Treasure hunting in the school and outdoors for the pupils as an practise of co-operation with phones/tablet computers. Teachers continue the meeting with the topics to be discussed (see the list above).

2 pm. Four (4) lessons of active citizenship (all partners prepare an presentation) to teachers and pupils.

5 pm. Getting to know the history and culture of Oulu by foot.

Thur March, 22nd

9.00 am. The school of Jääli.

9-11am. Workshops of discussion and debating of the topic "My school". Pupils attend math classes with the theme of graphics and practise making a simple graph by interviewing the people in the school.

Lunch 11 am.

12-1pm Presentation of the graphs.

1-3 pm: Attending home-economics class with special pupils to prepare some pastries for the Finnish night.

Teachers continue the meeting if needed.

4-7 pm. Finnish night.

Fri March, 23rd

9.00 The school of Jääli.

9-11 am. Pupils attend art classes to learn about four famous painters from four partner countries (one painter/country, each country preparing a presentation of one of their most famous painters).

11 am. Lunch

11.30 am. Pupils continue presenting artists and make artwork copying national art classics. Short drama exercises of the paintings. Preparing evaluation material of the meeting.

12 pm. Seminar for the teachers: Inclusion and active citizenship in Finnish schools.

2 pm: Preparing for next days' exercises.

Sat March 24th

The school of Jääli 9.00 am. Visiting places of cultural and sosiological importance. Exploring life on the Arctic circle. Pupils make interwievs during the exploration to expand their knowledge of the world and diversities in European cultures. Pupils make a Gallup and a graph of what they see and experience during the exploration by interwieving each others and their findings to their classmates back at home. They report the exploration to the Arctic circle to someone who's never been there.

Reading stories and regognizing co-operation as a phenomena from them. Pupils exchange their knowledge of the concept of 'active citizen'.

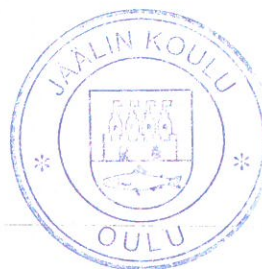

Working in transnational pairs/groups on a given subject and reporting it. Presentation of the results.
