

1 How to recognize me?	to perceive oneself from the outside → pupils describe teacher, then sample is made on blackboard (alternatively known person/Idol) – pupils draw themselves to the template, expand this	Boy or girl, face, hair, clothing style, favorite colors, typical utensils	Mirror, template, example (teacher)	pupils can be motivated and implemented according to their abilities occasionally note that this is not art teaching, so everyone can trust
