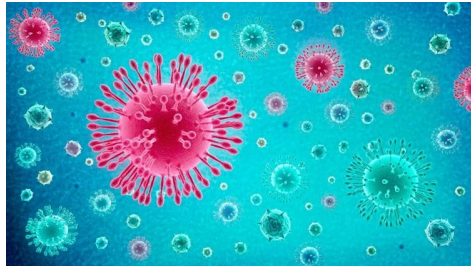

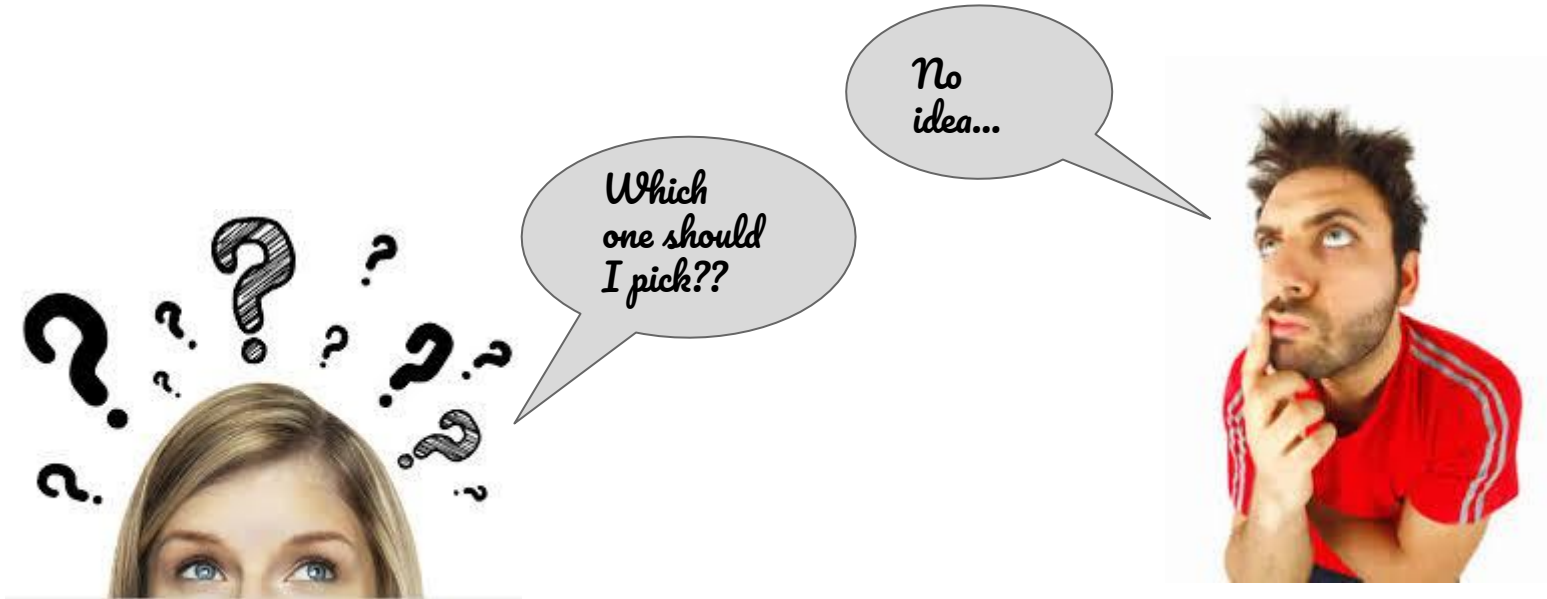

Specific cases...

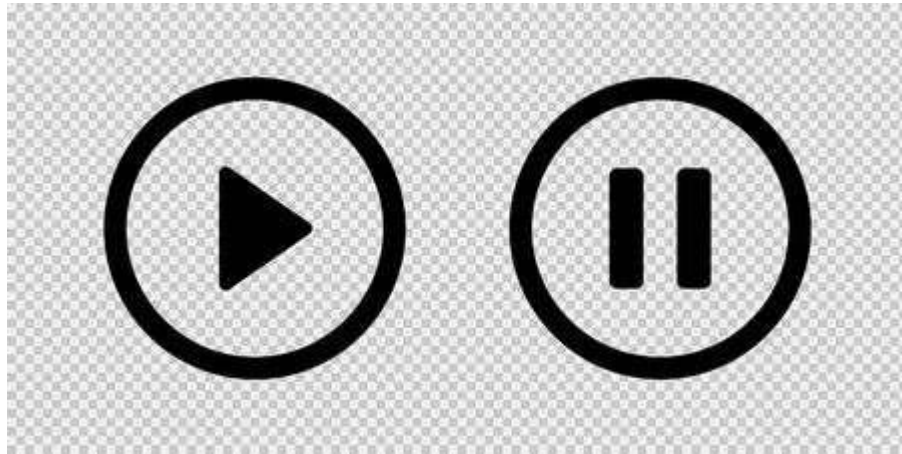
1 You are a teacher and you want to make educational videos for your students so they can use it **over and over...**

Manipulate the video: repeat, pause, play...

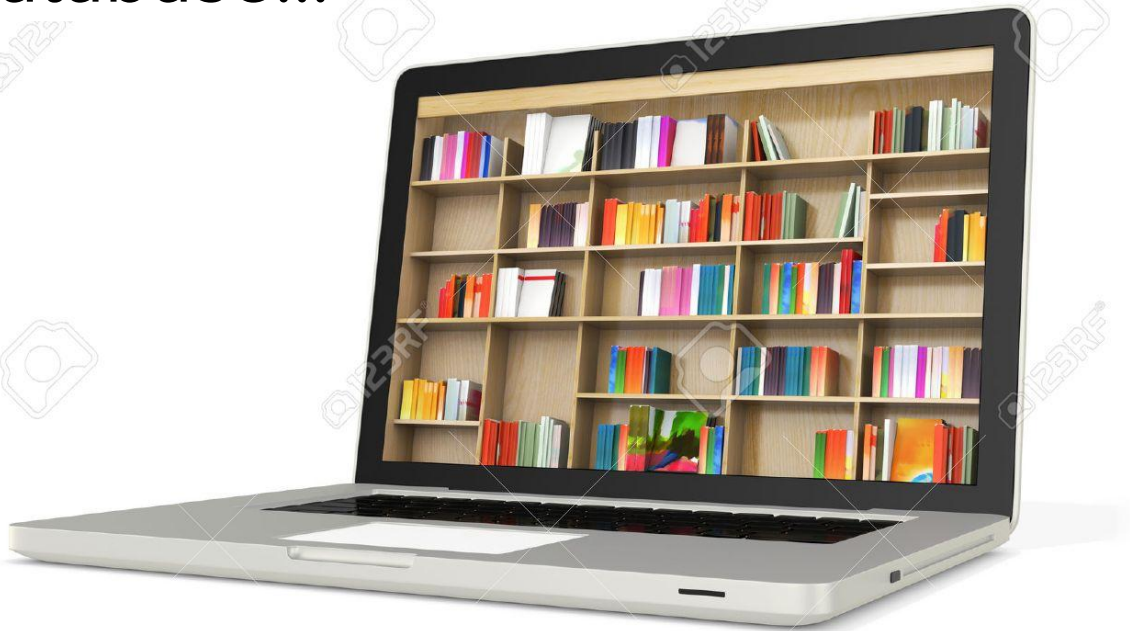




Adapted to the needs of teaching...

The 5 steps of screencasting:

DOWNLOAD SOFTWARE



Download software before the initial use.



SET UP



Clean up your desktop.



SCRIPT



Write the script of your video.

RECORD



Let's go!



SAVE & SHARE



Save the video and upload it to your preferred file-sharing location.
