Development of the Topics under Discussion

The meeting started at 10:00 am with the welcome speech of the school headmistress Mr. Mariola Zajdlic and the school teachers and students welcomed guests. Teachers from Poland greeted all the project participants and gave a short presentation of the day's agenda. After that, students and teachers were invited to look around the school.

Later on, the coordinators met in a classroom, where they were given special sets for each team containing project T-shirts, program information, leaflets about Poland and the region and evaluation forms to be filled after the meeting. Students and other teachers went to have workshops. After a brief introduction of the Polish teacher, Mrs Agnieszka Laskowska, and the distribution of tasks, the word was given to Project Coordinator Mrs Ayla Şavaşçi to open the 6th project meeting in Poland.

During the coordinators' meeting, the Main Coordinator touched upon topics as follows:

- 1) Mobility Tool (some aspects have been shown how to fill in the platform).
- 2) Meeting in France (tasks related to sustainability of the environment and writing skills have been discussed; students have been obliged to prepare a presentation on

the former and watch a video on the latter).

3) Intellectual Outputs 1 and 2 (teachers have discussed some English lessons covered in Output 1 that can be experimented with and have been given the printed working versions of Output 2).

4) eTwinning portal and the European Quality Label (teachers and students have been asked to work on the platform: fill in the Pages of TwinSpace and talk on the forum for improving communication among partners and making the project more visible).

5) Monthly activities of September and October (YEAR 2), e.g. flipbook about successful people and the translation of a fragment of a book by a British author of Indian origin, Savita Kalhan for the workshops in France.

6) Organization of the meetings in general.

7) Students' performance.

Coordinators worked until 14:30.

Meanwhile students were working in seven international groups doing the following activities:

11.00 - 12.30 INTEGRATION ACTIVITIES

Students and teachers from partner countries together with Polish hosts participated in integrational games run by Polish teachers: Mrs Agnieszka Szymańska, Mrs Ilona Stasiołek, and Mrs Monika Rzepecka.

At 12:30 there was a coffee-break and at 13:00 the meeting continued.

13.00 - 14.30 ARTS & CRAFTS - CREATIVE WORKSHOPS

Students and teachers from partner countries together with Polish hosts participated in workshops (they were divided into 7 international groups). At first, the groups were introduced to flipped instructions prepared and posted on various e-platforms

by the Polish team. The workshops focused on:

- “decoupage” - designing and decorating own unique pieces, workshops run by Mrs Agnieszka Pawlak;
- music - learning rhythms and trying skills playing different instruments; workshops run by Mrs Monika Rzepecka;
- jewellery tutorial - designing and producing own precious pieces; workshops run by Mrs Izabela Marczak.

Students created their own articles that they took home.

At 15:00 there was a lunch-break. Since most of the students and teachers were very tired after the whole day of activities, the organizers changed plans and decided to show presentations on Tuesday.

The meeting ended at approximately 16:30. All the participants received commemorative project T-shirts and souvenirs upon departure.

At 16:30 students left school and spent the rest of the day with their host families. Teachers returned to their hotel.

Development of the Topics under Discussion

The meeting started at 10:00 am. For this day, we agreed to wear the project T-shirts. We started with students' presentations that we couldn't see on Monday. Students showed the presentations made in PPT, Prezi and Camtasia. They created them before the meeting in national groups on the following topics:

"Successful entrepreneurs and creators",

"The lives and entrepreneurship stories of celebrities",

"Invention that has changed and facilitated our lives",

"The stories of successful leaders", "The lives of scientists",

"Successful people",

"Logo, trademark and slogan of a famous product",

"Successful businessmen".

At around 11:30, students were asked to participate in the creative workshops on INNOVATIVE PRODUCT. After a short break after the presentations, Polish teachers invited all the participants for a short "flipped learning" presentation of what INNOVATIVE PRODUCT is about and how to fulfill all the tasks. The 7 groups that were previously designed were also given written instructions. The teachers and students were working on laptops with already prepared templates in PPT.

Meanwhile, the coordinators with foreign teachers visited the City of Lodz Office

and talked with the Vice Mayor of Lodz, Mr Tomasz Trela. The coordinators exchanged small tokens of friendship and the Main Coordinator and the Principal of the Polish school gave the Vice Mayor a memorable project T-shirt. When the session finished, teachers were invited to look around the office to get acquainted with the office's history and its premises. After that, the coordinators and teachers went to school where the coordinators continued project talks and teachers joined the 7 international groups at workshops.

From 12:00 am till 13:00 pm the coordinator team had a meeting to evaluate some aspects of the project and discuss future events.

At 13:00 there was a coffee-break and at 13:30 the meeting continued with students and teachers from partner countries participating together with the Polish hosts in sports games prepared by Mr Tymoteusz Wagner. Before that, we all took a family photo to mark the event.

At 15:00 there was a lunch break after which students left school and spent the rest of the day with their host families. After 16:00 , teachers returned to their hotel.

At 17:00, teachers went on a guided tour around Łódź with Mrs Dorota Karło, who made them acquainted with the city's history and landmarks (i.e. palaces of rich factory tycoons from 19th century, Manufaktura shopping mall and the Lidzianski Ghetto). Teachers had a chance to use rickshaws, a popular means of transport in Piotrkowska Street. The meeting ended late in the evening. -----

Development of the Topics under Discussion

The meeting started at 07:00 am. All the foreign teachers went to Kraków. The group took a guided tour of the Wawel Castle, the Rynek Underground History Museum, the Sukiennice and the Main Square of the Kraków's Old Town.

Our partners could get acquainted with the history of Kraków and Poland, wander around picturesque streets and landmarks, visit art galleries, admire one of the famous Leonardo da Vinci's painting "Lady with an ermine" and buy souvenirs. The meeting ended at approximately 23:00.
