What you will need:

9 or 10" paper plate
White construction paper
Pink construction paper
Adhesive: school glue or glue stick
Scissors
Crayon or marker
Yarn
Hole punch


- 1. Cut eye holes in plate.
- 2. Cut two long ears from white construction paper.
- 3. Cut the inside of the ears and the nose from pink construction paper.
- 4. Glue ears and nose as shown in photograph.
- 5. Draw on mouth.
- 6. Hole punch two holes in sides of plate. Tie pieces of yarn on to plate.
- 7. Have child put mask on and tie yarn in back of their head.

Have fun with this quick and easy mask.



Egg Template






Rabbit Template





Easter Chicken Egg Cups




Easter Chicken Egg Cups



What you need


Eggshells


Grass seeds or bean seeds

Tempera paints or markers

Glue


A small piece of a pipe cleaner Clean eggshells and dry them gently. To give the tiny plant pot a solid base, glue a small piece of pipecleaner twisted into a circle.







Using tempera paint or markers, decorate the eggshells. Let the paint dry.

Put potting soil in the eggshells (fill a little over half way). Add many grass seeds or two bean seeds. The grass seeds take a few weeks to germinate, but bean seeds will sprout in just a few days.








Cover the seeds with a little bit of soil, and sprinkle lightly with water. When the seeds sprout, put the tiny plant pot in a sunny spot and enjoy.

Spotted Easter Eggs

What you will need:

Boiled eggs Paper towels Alcohol inks in desired colors Toilet paper tubes Scissors Newspapers or wax paper Shampoo (the cheaper the better)





- 1. Cover working area with newspapers or wax paper.
- 2. Dry eggs thoroughly with paper towels.
- 3. Open alcohol ink and drop single drops on eggs in random fashion. Use one or more colors on egg. Let dry.
- 4. Cut toilet paper tube to desired height.
- 5. Drop single drops of alcohol ink on toilet paper tube and let dry.
- 6. Stand egg up on decorated toilet paper tube.
- 7. Wash hands with shampoo. The cheaper shampoos seem to be more effective at cleaning hands.

Note: Please make sure to refrigerate eggs promptly if planning on consuming at a later time. Refer to your cookbook for cooking instructions and freshness of eggs.


Floppy-Eared Bunny

Instruction Sheet


Materials needed:

- choice of papers
- glue or glue stick
- scissors
- markers or crayons
- chalk optional
- glitter glue pen -optional
- pipe cleaners- optional
- 1. Enlarge pattern to desired size.
- 2. Cut out all pattern pieces in your choice of colors.
- Lay the head/face piece flat, large side down
- 4. Use the glue stick to attach the nose. Generally, the nose should go in the center, where the small part of the head meets the large part, but don't be afraid to be creative! Add it where you think it should go!
- 5. Draw an appropriate mouth, leaving a spot for the teeth below the mouth.
- 6. Add whiskers with thin strips of construction paper or with pipe cleaners.
- 7. Decide if your bunny will have a hair bow or a bow tie, and attach appropriately.
- 8. Add the flop ears to the top of your bunny.
- 9. For extra fun, consider adding eye lashes, pink cheeks and ear center colors with glitter glue pens or chalk!










