GO! LYCEUM AALST - BELGIUM

Lyceum Aalst is a school located in the centre of the city. It offers general secondary education to students aged 11-18: economics, modern languages, human sciences, classical languages, science. The school population has 550 students, 50 teachers. They guide students in becoming European citizens of the future with key competences and values: freedom, embracing cultural diversity, tolerance, non-discrimination combined with building a strong, critical personality.





KUOPIO- FINLAND: Minna Canth School

It's a secondary school in the central area in Kuopio. There are about 620 pupils in grades 7-9, and 25 pupils in grade 10. The school has six music classes and three dance classes. It's essential to widely integrate physical activation of students.

Schools involved in the project:





The schools has 26 teachers and over 350 students from 4 months old to 16 years old. The levels of education are from kindergarden to secondary. A safe learning environment where all students are important is provided. The open communication between parents, students, and teachers is valued and intellectual curiosity and creative thinking is promoted





It's located in the south-east of Romania, on the left bank of the Danube river. It is a rural school There are 334 students, from 3-15 years old. The purpose of the school is to prepare students for life and it is based more on the relationship between school - student - family. The school is very active in sports, social projects, environmental issues and other areas that are on the concern of the community.


In addition to these channels, some activities have also been carried out to promote and give visibility to our project such as:
