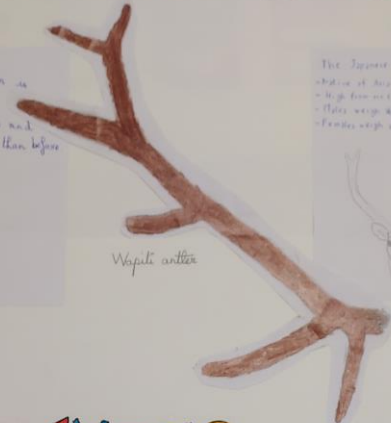


# DEERS

## Small deer:

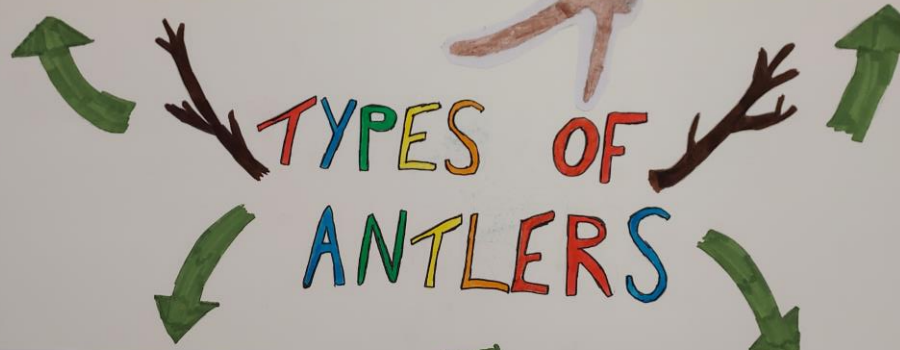
- The males carry small antlers of 0.30 to 1.50 m in adulthood.
- They lose their antlers every year between October and December, they regrow right away and are bigger than before.
- The females haven't antlers.

## The Japanese deer

- Antlers of deer
- They grow more, more
- They weigh about 100kg
- Females weigh about 40kg
- Similar to Red Deer
- Brown coat with white spots
- The antlers grow in spring and they are taken to the mating season
- The antlers are full inside
- The inside of the antler is brown in white with a velvet sheathing.



## European deer / Alas. Moose

- The size and grow rate of the antlers is determined by diet and age
- After the mating season, males drop their antlers to conserve energy for the winter and they regrow in the spring.



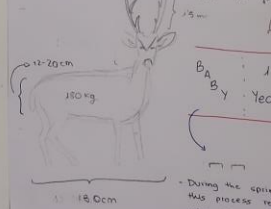
## Red deer:

- The red deer antlers are about 70 cm long and weigh about 1 kg.
- They have variable shapes depending on the age and health of the deer.

- My species is one of the largest deer species. We are 4.7 million of Red deers in Europe.

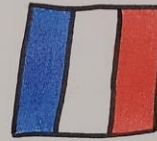

When the eggs are found in the nests they're taken to internal incubators to protect them from the birds.

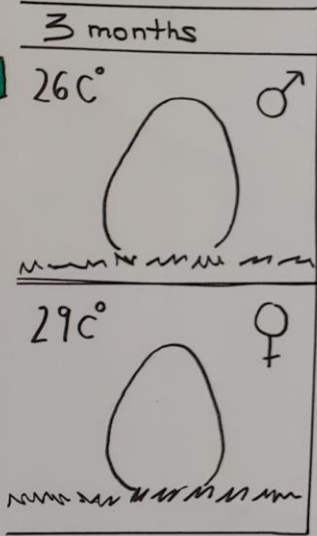
When the Cistudes are around 5 years old they get released in the nature because they're too big from to be eaten by birds

# The life of the cistude turtles



At the beginning of its life, the cistude is carnivorous and then it is herbivorous. It eats injured or dead fish.

The cistude lives in canals, rivers, ponds. It needs a sandy soil to lay its eggs.

The life expectancy of the cistude is 40 to 60 years.

Cistudes have "two skeletons", one internal and one external.

The breeding season for cistude extends from the beginning of April to the end of May.
