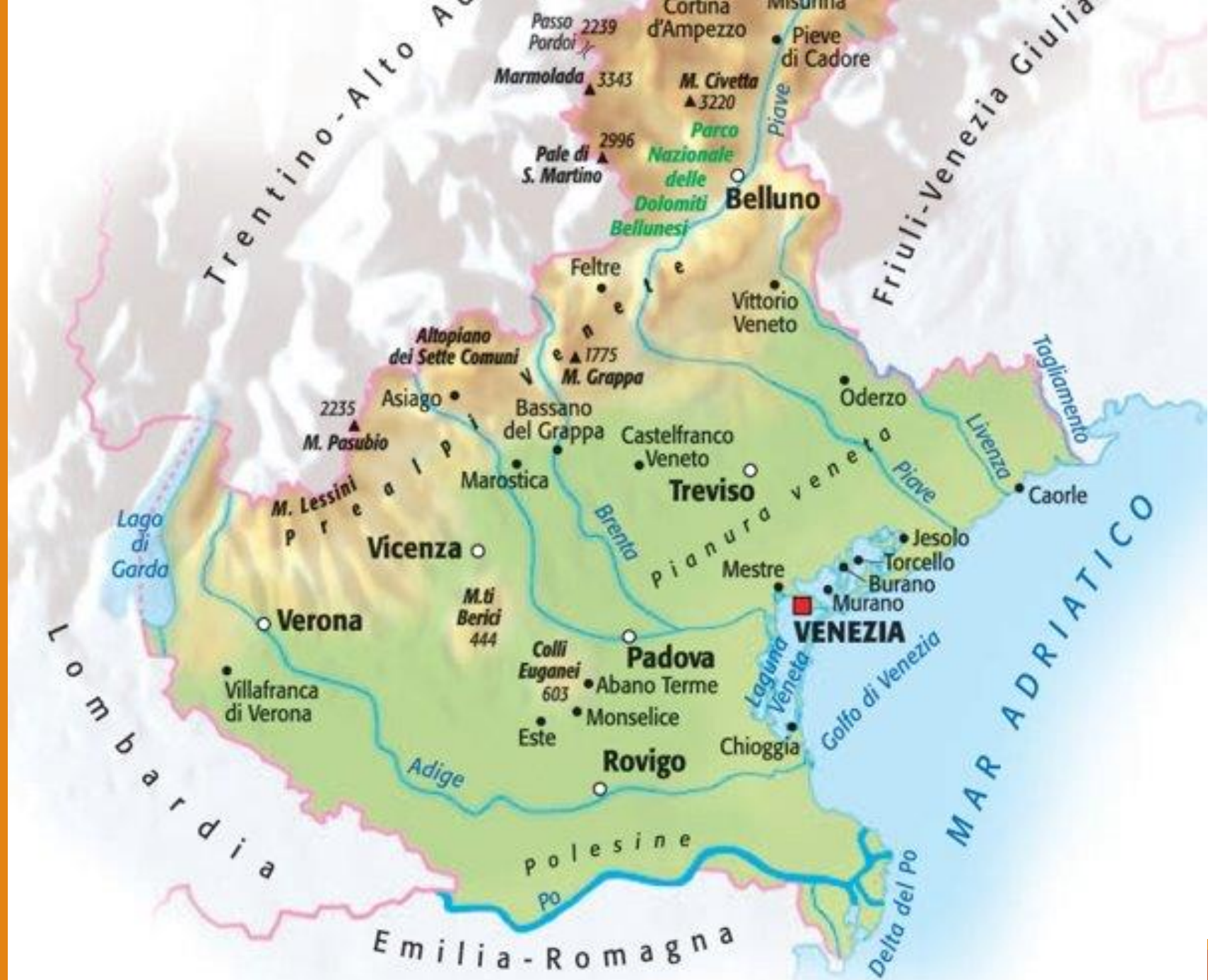

MOUNTAINS

The 30% of the Veneto is made up of mountains and here are the most beautiful mountains in Italy.

The most important are :

- Monte Baldo (2218 m)
- Cinque Torri (2361 m)
- Tre Cime di Lavaredo (3000 m)

DOLOMITES

The Dolomites in my opinion are the most beautiful mountains of Italy.

There is a National Park, nine Natural Parks and the biggest ski complex of Italy.

On June 26, 2009, UNESCO declared them a World Heritage Site.

The name derives from the high presence of dolomite material in the soil.



CORTINA

Cortina it's in the middle of the Conca d'Ampezzo. It was an ancient thermal basin of an ancient glacier.

The origin of the name is probably the decrease of the latin name "curtis" which probably indicates that wealthy families lived in this place.



CORTINA CHAMPIONSHIP 2021

This year the world ski championship took place in Cortina.

The venue was decided by the FIS congress in Cancún on June 10, 2016.

The program included downhill, supergiant, giant slalom, special slalom, combined and parallel slalom races, all for both men and women, and a mixed team competition.





RIVER

The two longest rivers in Italy flow in Veneto: the Po, which marks a large part of the border with Emilia-Romagna and the Adige; also the Piave and the Brenta reach a considerable length.

PO

The Po was born in Monviso,
Pian del Re and flows into the
Adriatic Sea.

Its tributaries are: Dora Baltea,
Dora Riparia, Tanaro, Trebbia,
Panaro, Bormida, Orco, Sesia,
Ticino, Secchia, Lambro, Parma,
Taro, Mincio and Adda.

It is 652 km long.

It crosses Piedmont Lombardy
Emilia-Romagna Veneto.





PIAVE

The Piave was born in Monte Paralba and flows into the Adriatic Sea near Cortellazzo.

Its tributaries are: Padola, Ansiei, Boite, Vajont, Maè, Rai, Cordevole, Caorame, Sonna, Soligo.

It is 231 km long.

LAKES

The lakes of Veneto are one of the things to see absolutely if you are on holiday in this region.

The most beautiful are :

- Lago di Garda
- Lago di Misurina
- Lago di Sorapis





BEACH

The coasts in Veneto are both low and sandy and low and marshy.

The most beautiful beaches are those of Eraclea, Chioggia, Rosolina and Jesolo.





JESOLO BEACH

Fifteen kilometers of beach, of characteristic piers reaching out to the sea, between the mouths of the Piave and the Sile: this is Lido di Jesolo, that someone already dares to call the European Miami.

Just half an hour from Venice, this coast is one of the family paradises of our Old Continent.

PROSECCO

Prosecco is a white wine produced in Veneto that became known in the nineties as Prosecco

Prosecco is the most exported Italian wine abroad. In 2014 it surpassed Champagne for the first time in terms of the number of bottles sold worldwide.

Since 2019 the Prosecco Hills of Conegliano and Valdobbiadene have been included in the UNESCO World Heritage List.
