Savoyard Self

- An association located in Chambéry, Savoie.
- It's a humanitarian association
- Mr Batista.



History

- The association was created 33 years ago.
- It was created after the death of a homeless person
- 4 persons were mobilized, the Savoyard Self was born.



Financing

- The Savoyard Self is a non profit organisation.
- Half of the funding is financed by the State and the City Council.
- A meal at Savoyard Self-Service Restaurant costs €1.20



Organisation

- The Savoyard Self is open daily (even Sundays and Bank Holidays).
- Daily schedule of the self-service restaurant :
 - Collection (9h00 to 12h00)
 - Preparing the meals (9h00 to 12h00)
 - Lunch service(11h30 to 12h40).
 - Dinner service(18h30 to 19h00).



Collection

- The food collection is between 9h00 and 12h00
- Collection is done thanks to 2 small vans which transport the leftovers.



Food (collection)

- The food which is collected is transported to the headquarters of the association
- Food is kept in a cold room before cooked



Food management

- Savoyard self collects leftovers all year around thanks to donations
- 60000 meals are distributed by the association per year.



Food types

- The association cannot accept all leftovers donated because it is necessary to follow government hygiene rules.
- Food most collected are: starch (pastas, potatoes, bread) fruit and vegetables.



Meal schedule

- Lunch begins at 11:30 am and finishes at 12:40 pm
- The Savoyard canteen is the only association which serves hot meals.



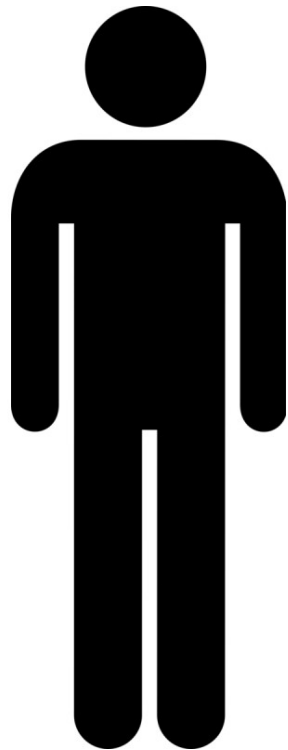
Meal schedule

- A meal at the Cantine Savoyarde costs €1.20, however for the first 10 days meals are free.



The profile of the person who eats at the savoyard self

- The Savoyard canteen welcomes everybody
- 80 % are men and 20 to 30 % have accommodation (housing)



The Staff

- The association has 9 permanent employees and numerous volunteers.
- At the beginning --> 4 founding members,
- today --> 500 subscribers (donors, members; staff and including 150 volunteers)

- The volunteer promises to respect the dignity and belief of users as well as the rules of the association

The Self service

- The self service can accept a maximum of 95 people per meal, however, it is rarely filled to full capacity .
