The colors on this map indicate the most widely used and most widely spoken languages in the world, and where they are spoken. Throughout its history, the Basque language has had almost no official recognition, it has never been used in the administration in its entire field.

In the world there are around 7097 languages and, according to UNESCO, at least 3000 languages are at risk of extinction. If we put the languages in order of speakers from 10 to 0 (10 is the language with the most speakers and 0 is the language with the fewest speakers) (as Ethnologue says) Chinese is 10, and the Basque around 9. Believe it or not, Basque has 1,000,000 speakers.

#### How many languages are in the world?

There are, more or less, 7.000 languages in the world: Basque, Thai, Ukrainian, Romanian, Galician, Catalan, Breton, Quechua, Swedish, Latin, Finnish, Japanese, Braille, Indonesian, Klingon, Mongolian, Hungarian, Polish, Danish, Norwegian...




#### Why do we see ourselves as so small?
