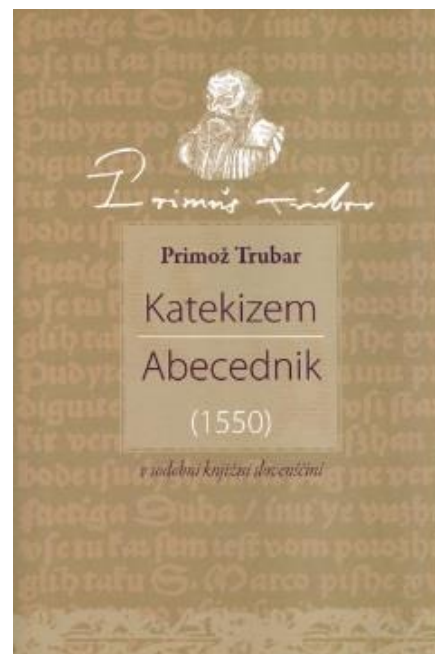


The Reformation day

The 31 st of October is the Reformation day which is celebrated in Slovenia as a national holiday. Reformation has given the Slovenian nation the first book and with that literary language, and for the first time the Slovenian word has been mentioned.



The main person of the Slovenian protestantism is Primož Trubar (1508-1586). He has written more than 25 works or a half of all the books, that have been written by the protestantisms writers. In the 1550 he wrote Katekizem, the first book in the Slovenian language and the first printed book, Abecednik.

In 1517, professor of Bible, Martin Luther hang 95 thesis on the church door in Wittenberg. He criticized the catholic religion and he wanted changes. With that the reformation movement started and caused a lot of changes in the catholic religion.

The most important work of the Slovenian protestantism is the translation of Bible by Jurij Dalmatin in 1584.

In the times of the Reformation the first Slovenian manuscript was formed, Zimske urice by Adam Bohorič, that has traced the Slovenian writing in the next two decades.

In Slovenia the Reformation day, 31 st of October, has been a national holiday since 1992 and it is free of work.
