

BYOD (Bring Your Own Device)

BYOD is a new trend. The pupils bring their own device at school (Smartphone, tablet, ...) and use it in the classroom. Then pupils don't use their smartphones only for fun (games, SMS, social networks...), they get used to use it to work at school.

Example:

Unit: Every people has its talent

Getting ready:

- show a video (reality show, people showing what they can do)
- The teacher says: "Everyone has a talent, what is yours?"
- The teacher gives: I can, I am able to, I can manage, I'm in order to ...
- Homework : Tell us, what is your talent!?!

Next hour:

- Build tandems (groups of 2 pupils)
- Teacher's instruction: you and your friend have seen the reality show. You want to participate. Each of you speaks about its own talent. Imagine and write the dialog.
- The pupils write down the dialog (using what they prepared at home). They are allowed to use an online-dictionary on their smartphone
- They train and play the scene
- They record themselves
- They deliver their recording to the teacher per bluetooth or per email

That's it. The pupils really love this kind of activity, you can see it during the activity, you can hear it then. Every pupil comes to speak. And every pupil speaks more than by any other lesson (y).
