- o it dropped a sword in a place, where now budapest is
- he can be found as a statue on the bridge of liberty in

  pregnant
- in some other versions of the story she was already pregnant when she was visited by him
- e her son was called Álmos (by hungarian: dream álom)
- Arpåden kings followed (by Álmos' son Árpad)
- 1001 1301: first hungarian kingdom
