

OVERCOMING STEREOTYPES BLOG CREATION

Follow the steps you have below in order to work the content of your future blog on Stereotypes.

1. Stereotypes

- 1.1. Define *stereotypes* and describe the ways that stereotypes are measured.
- 1.2. Classifying stereotypes. Describe the different types of stereotypes: (Gender, Religion, Cultural, Racial, Sex orientation, Others (eating habits, dressing habits....))
- 1.3. Advantages and disadvantages to stereotyping (positive and negative stereotypes).

2. Stereotypes impact on feelings and behavior

- 2.1. Definition: Prejudices (emotion) and Discrimination (behavior)
- 2.2. Write examples of different situations (from different countries or general ones) which show prejudice and discrimination based on stereotypes.

3. Cases analysis

Choose situations from stereotypes (1 or 2 cases for each type listed below) that may rise prejudice or discrimination nowadays. Describe the stereotype situation, and its prejudices or discrimination (reactions by society against the situation or stereotype)

1. Gender
2. Religion
3. Racial or ethnical
4. Sex orientation
5. Cultural: based on the ones seen on the presentations about Hungary, Italy, Germany, Spain or Catalonia.
6. Others

4. “Combating and avoiding prejudice or discrimination”

From each case-situation described before, find solutions or recommendations to overcome them.

5. How to overcome stereotypes: Rules of Tolerance

After analyzing the situations and finishing all the previous steps, establish some rules that would help society fighting against prejudice and discrimination and/or avoiding stereotypes. Create a list of rules. (use the modal verbs to write them)

6. once you have discussed and agreed on the previous points, create the blog.



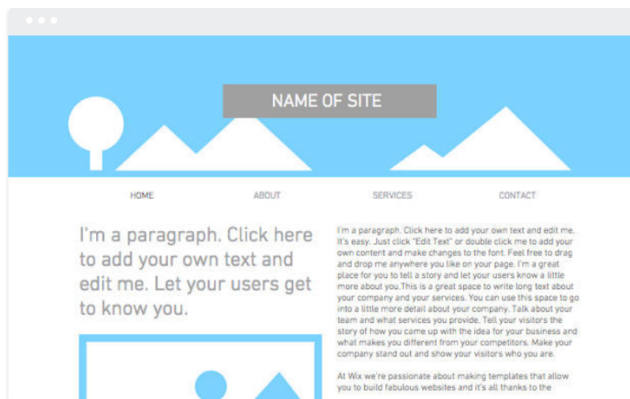

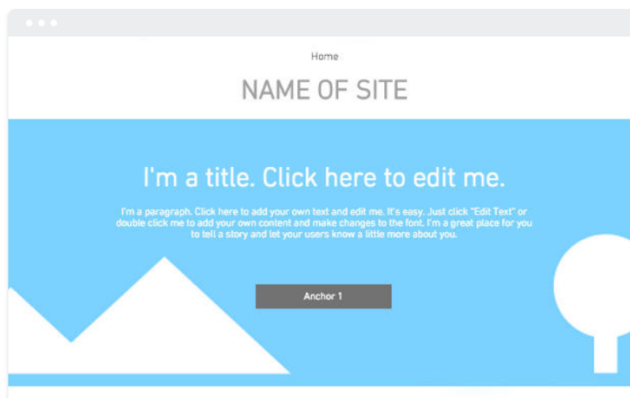
Start from Scratch

a. The easiest ones may be: Strip Header Layout and One Page Layout



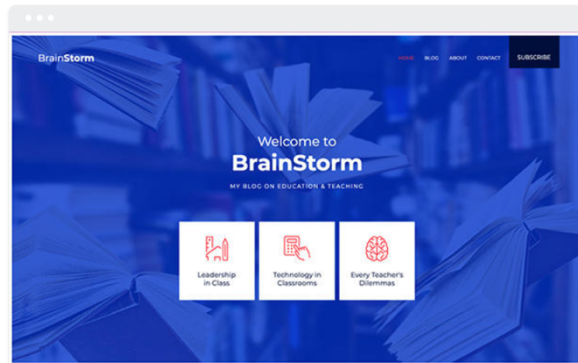
Strip Header Layout



One Page Layout

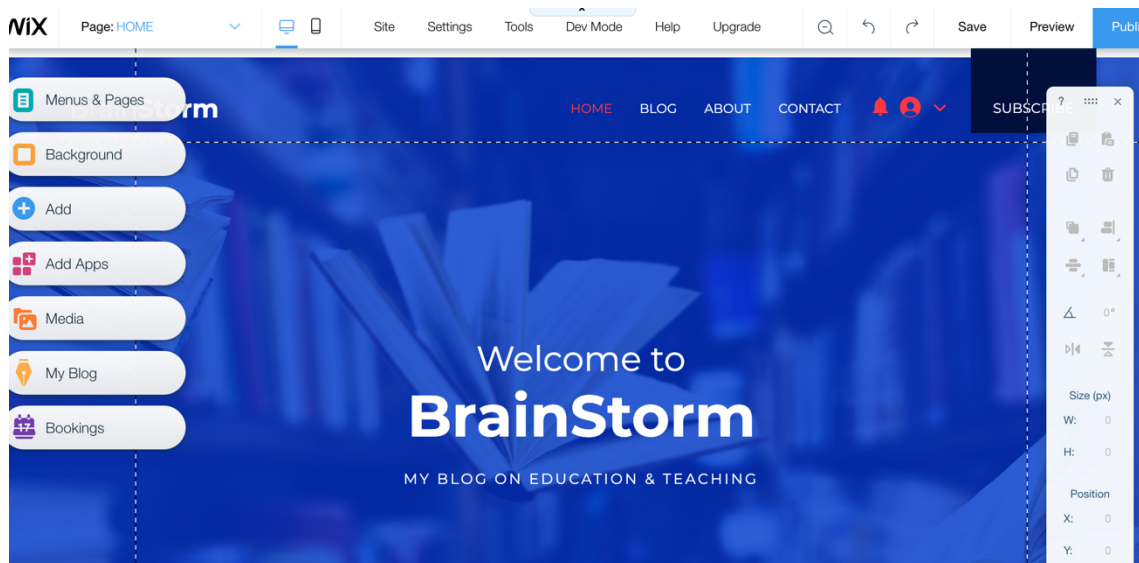
b. Or you can choose the education blog layout (from community & Education picks)

6. When you have decided the layout, you can start editing the blog: Using the tools you have.



You can add or delete pages, you can rewrite on them.

As you are 8 groups, each site should have a different name based on Stereotypes. Tell the name to your teachers before starting the blog.

The Blog should include the following parts.

1. **Stereotypes:** definition and the different types of stereotypes, as well as advantages and disadvantages of stereotyping. (add the source from which you get the information)
2. **Stereotypes impact on feelings and behavior**
3. **Stereotypes: cases analysis**
4. **“Combating and avoiding prejudice or discrimination”** (divide this part of the blog within as many parts as cases you solve)

5. **How to overcome stereotypes: Rules of Tolerance** (list the rules you have decided that are necessary to overcome stereotypes. As in some cases analysis you may find the same solution, generalize the rules)
6. **Contact or participants page:** under the name: **Roots of Europe participants:** list the names of the schools, their addresses, logo, website link.

Decide if each part is a page or you include some parts on only one page. Creativity and design are up to you! BE CREATIVE AND

IMPORTANT

- A. when you add representative pictures, make sure you can freely use the pictures you choose.
- B. Add logos down on the main page: Erasmus+ and Roots project logo. As well as the disclaimer text. Ask your teachers for these logos and disclaimer text.
- C. Add Creative Commons logo permissions. Ask your teachers for the CC logo.
