HIS HISTORY

The Greek Theater of Dodona is a classical theater built in Ancient Greece during the reign of Pirro for his soldiers. (318 a.C-272 a.C) He is considered one of the best generals of his time, and one of the great rivals of the Roman Republic during its expansion.

Location:

The theater is located within the Sanctuary of Dodona, which is located 80 km east of the island of Corfu, in the region of Epirus.

History;

King Pirro of Epiro built it in the 3rd century BC. C., as an extension of the sanctuary of Dodona. It was destroyed by the Aetolians in the year 219 a. C. but later it was rebuilt until, in the year 167 a. C., was again destroyed by troops of the Roman Empire.

Architecture:

Shape: amphitheater

Capacity: 18,000 people seated.

Orchestra area 18 meters in diameter with the altar dedicated to Dioniso.

Stage with two levels with a facade that measured 31.2 x 9.1
