

## Worth seeing places in my city.

The Municipality of Zografou is on the eastern suburbs of Athens. It has 71.126 people. It's 4km away from the city centre.

At the east there's Mount Imittos. Although it's near the city centre, it's full of greenery.

The area had a lot of crops and forests in the past. In the mid 20th century the area developed following the construction of Athens.

It took it's name from Ioannis Zografos, member of Theodoros Diligiannis' party, who bought a large area in 1902.

### What's worth seeing

- \* Zografou Villa which is used as a self-managed social place.
- \* Vonaparti Villa housing the Family Counseling Centre of the Municipality.
- \* Voutyra Villa used as a cultural centre
- \* Gounaropoulos Museum and Art Gallery. It is the house of George Gounaropoulos our famous Greek painter.
- \* The Church of Agios Therapontas, the most imposing temple of the area
- \* Kotopouli Museum is the house of a famous Greek actress, now used as a museum and art gallery.

\* The Goudi Park is a place with buildings that served as a military camp, in the past. Now it is a place full of trees, birds and parrots! The citizens use it as recreation and sports center.
