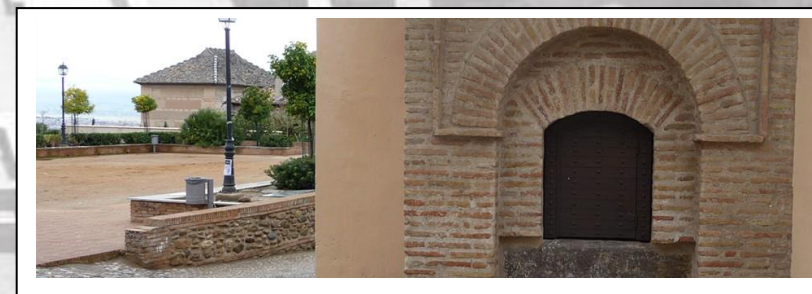
Do you dare?
