The village is not very big but interesting !










Murviel is an old village. The Romans built an **<u>oppidum</u>** and a villa on top of the hill.

The village is surrounded by forests.


The village attracts new inhabitants every year.

- He became a Member of Parliament in the 1950s.









Vincent Badie Secondary School is situated in the village of Montarnaud.
