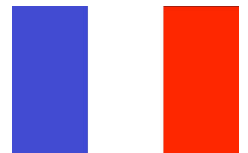

We have been involved in many international programmes over the past few years. Participation in this one is seen as an opportunity to develop our Duke of Edinburgh Award Programme within an international context. We would also like to introduce International Duke of Edinburgh to the partnership as a whole.

To explain what Duke of Edinburgh Award is (in brief) students are expected to;

- a) spend 30 hours developing a new skill (this is an intellectual skill, could be a language or an art or craft activity, flying a glider, learning to play an instrument.....)
- b) Spend 30 hours developing a new physical activity or participating in an existing one. (Football, cycling, horse riding, winter sports...losing weight, getting fit...)
- c) Spend 15 - 30 hours in a community based activity (not really obviously related to programme)
- d) Spend a couple of days walking and camping
