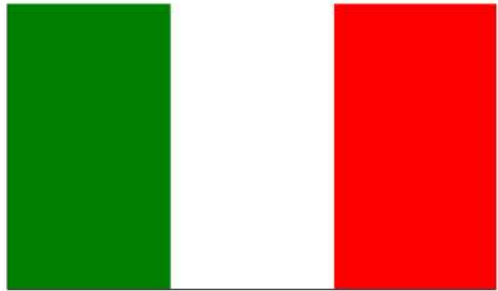

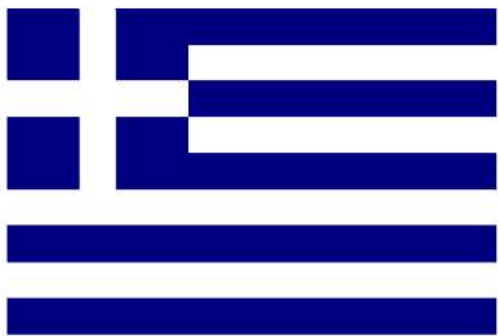

A brief history



- Segovia was a very important city between the 14th and the 16th centuries.
- Segovia was conquered by the Romans in 98 B.C.
- In 1088, after a period of Arab rule, Segovia was conquered and repopulated by Christian King Alfonso VI.
- Between the 12th and the 15th centuries, several of the kings of Castilla lived in Segovia.
- Isabella, the “Catholic Queen”, was crowned the queen of Castilla in our city.
- In the 16th century, Segovia had a great industrial growth. It became well known for making cloth.

Segovia is our city (55.000 people). It was declared a “World Heritage Site” by UNESCO.

It is a beautiful city with a lot of medieval monuments that you can see on the Internet.

We are close to Madrid (1 hour by motorway or 30 minutes by high speed train).

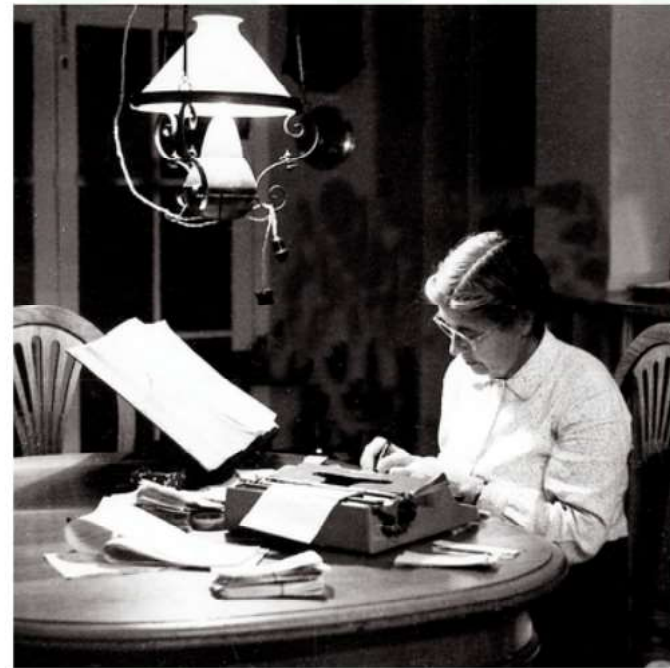
