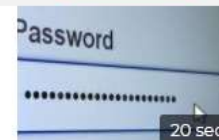

AdBlock

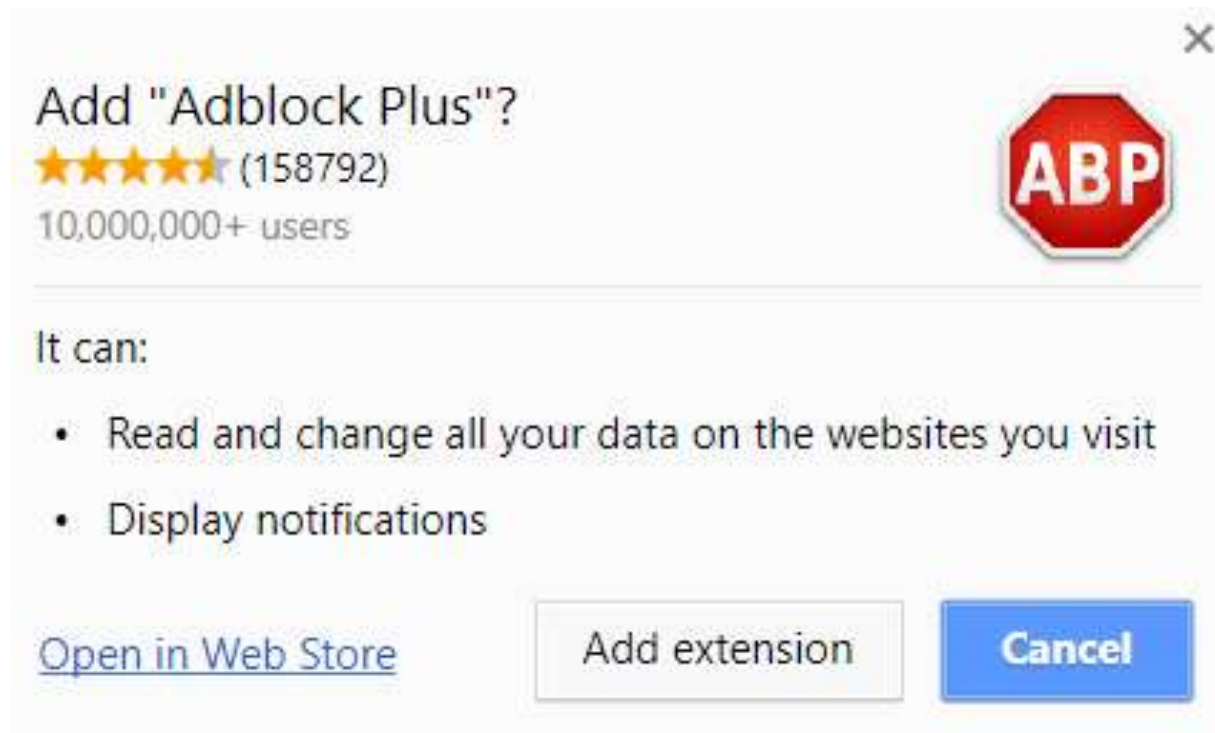


- Here is the process, how you can install Adblock to your computer:
- Firstly, you have to type: `adblockplus.org` to the search bar, then click „Agree and Install for Chrome”.
