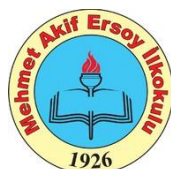




## “INSIDE OUT”

## CORONA VIRUS

Our school, Agrupamento de Escolas de Moimenta da Beira, is attended by 1144 students and 179 teachers work in it. However, more specifically, Escola Básica e Secundária de Moimenta da Beira, which is part of that grouping of schools, is attended by 731 11-to-18-year-olds. It is the partner school of the Erasmus+ “Inside Out” project. It is also the headquarters of Agrupamento de Escolas de Moimenta da Beira.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, lots of strict rules and regulations have been set up at our school since May 18<sup>th</sup>, the time in which lessons at school for 16-17-18-year-olds started again until the end of June. All the other students went on having online lessons.

In this new 2020-2021 school year, the same strict rules and regulations are being carried out: all students, teachers and other staff have to wear masks, hands have to be sanitized (for example, as soon

as you enter the main school gate, you have to sanitize them and this procedure has to be done several times a day), distancing in classrooms is kept and timetables have undergone several adaptations to avoid big gatherings of students and teachers in the breaks.

Luckily, up to now, no cases of the corona virus have come up in our school. Let's hope for such a situation to go on... However, if a student in a class gets infected, the whole class will stop coming to school and will start having online lessons. Other measures have been designed and will immediately take place if any students/teachers or other staff get infected.
