Lunch is 40 minutes

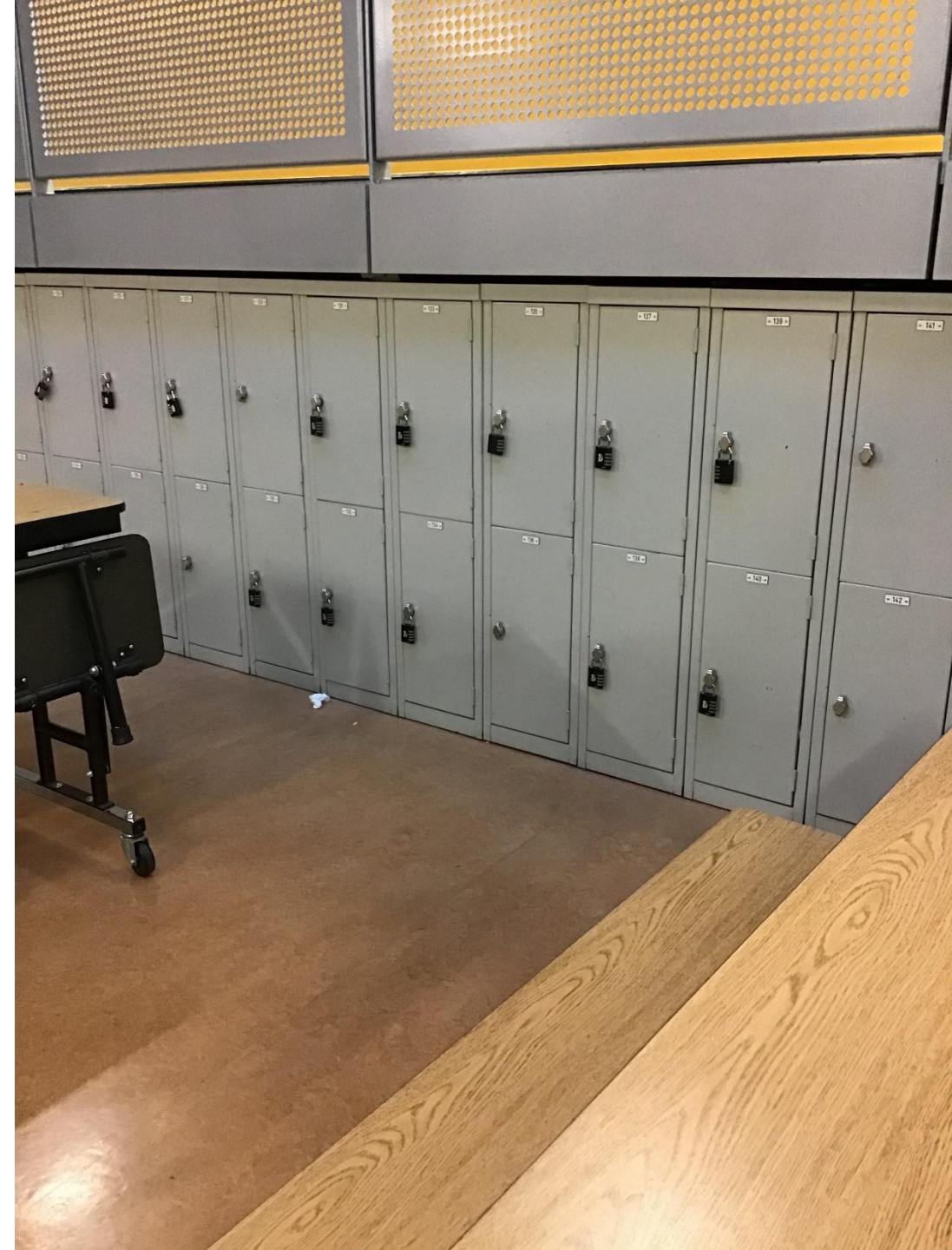
2 classes after lunch

# Our Lockers

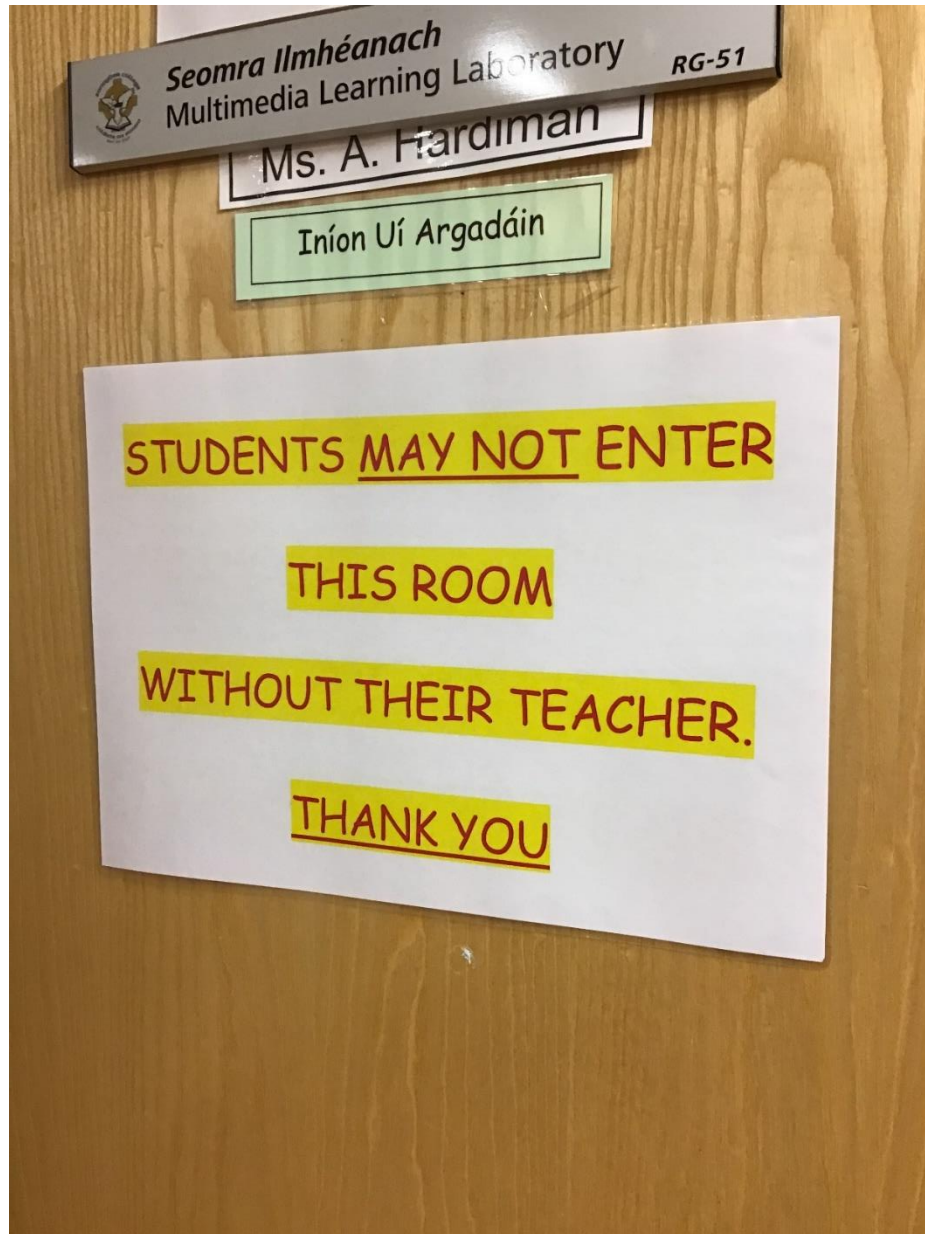
Each student has their own locker. They can use their locker to store books, copies etc.





# Rules of rooms

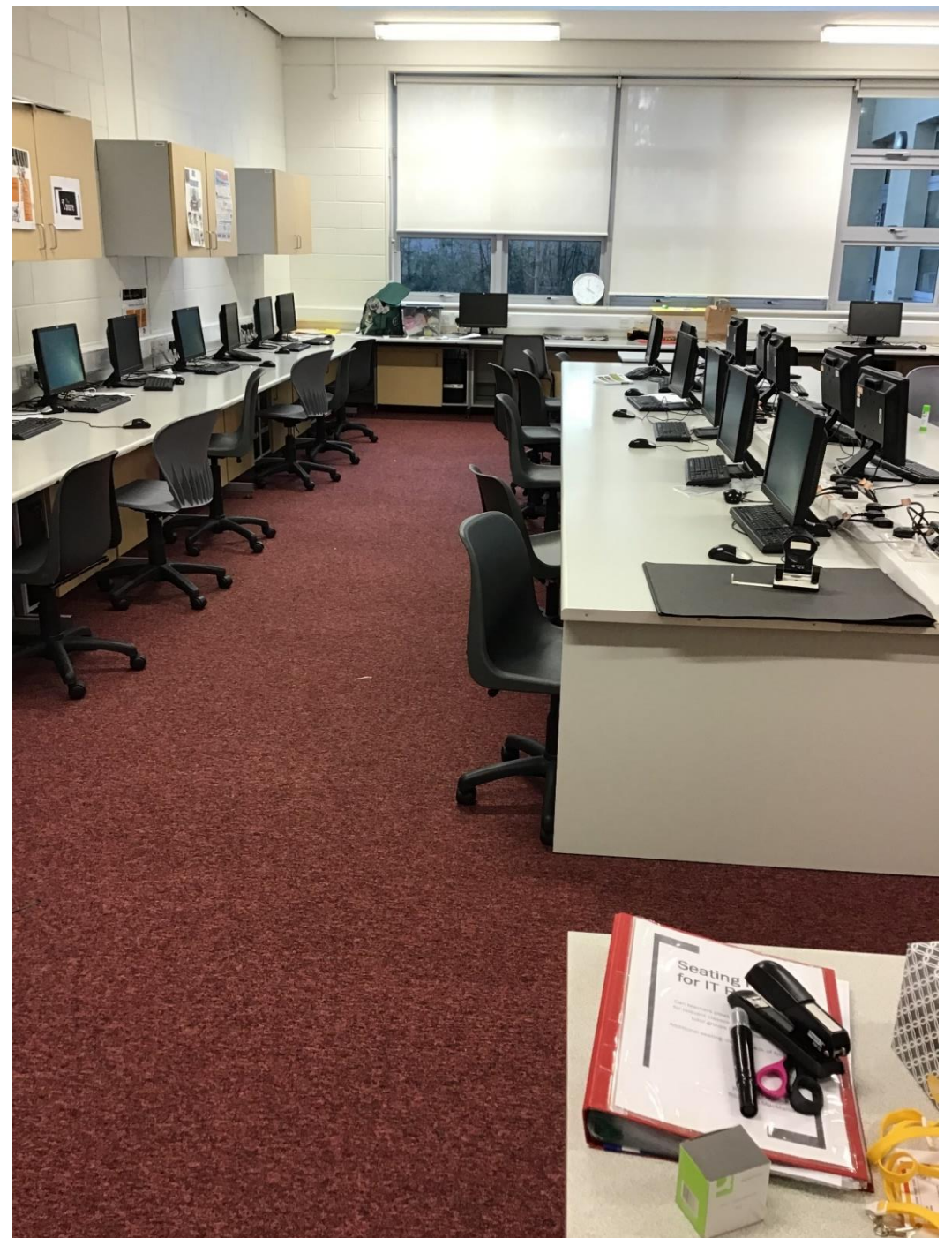
Students are not

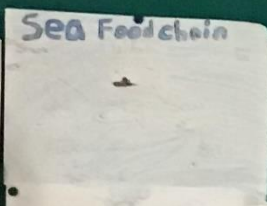
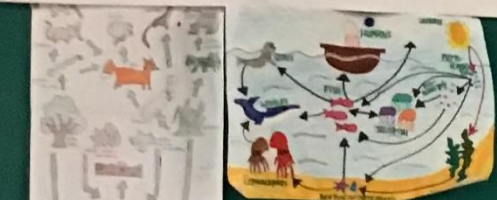

# Break and lunch time.


There are different areas for students to meet their friends. In this area games like table tennis can be played.
