WHAT IS ITS CLIMATE LIKE?



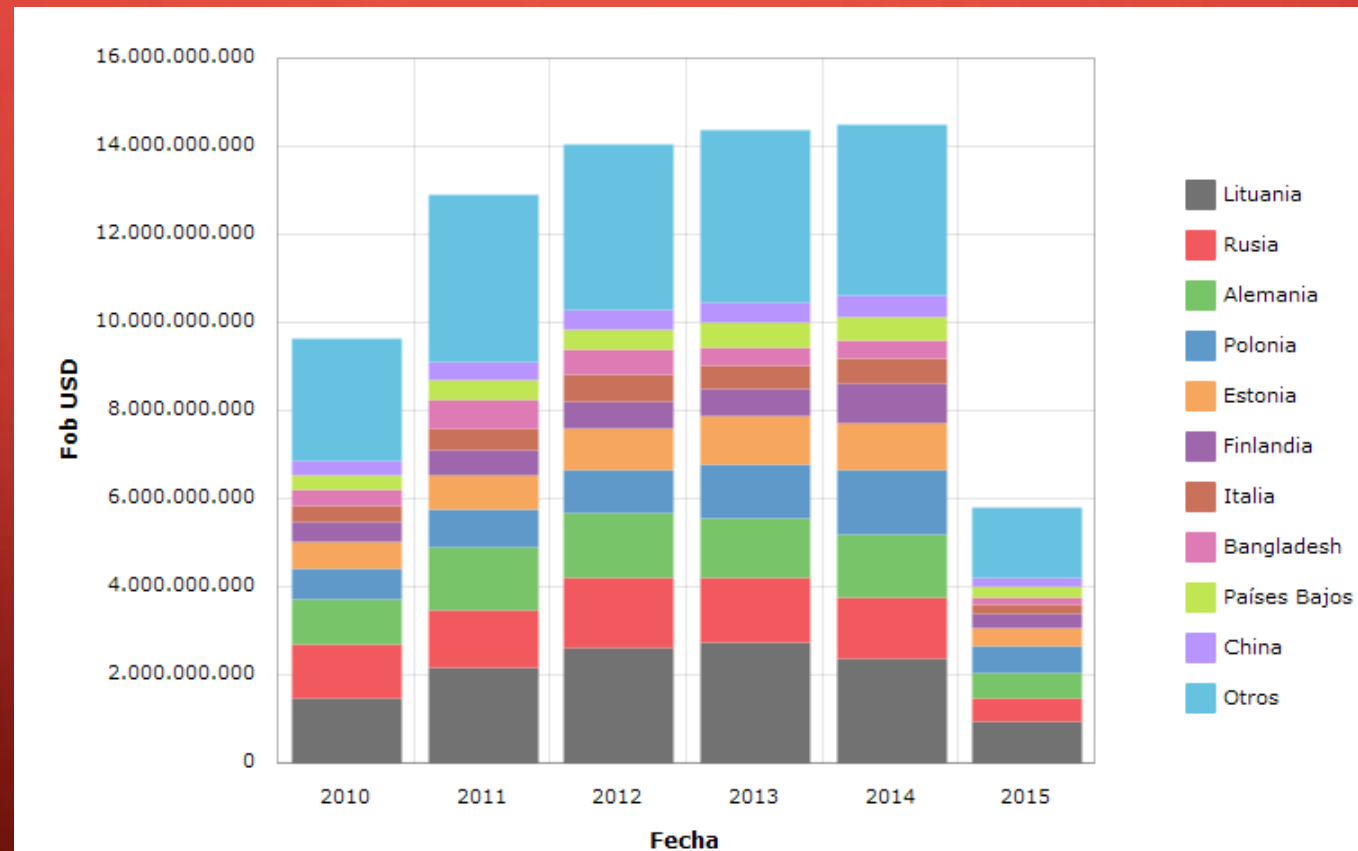
- Due to the latitude in which it is found, Latvia has a cold climate. Summers are cold and winters are very cold.
