Through eTwinning, teachers create projects that develop


- ▶ inclusion


WHAT IS EDUCATION FOR DEMOCRATIC CITIZENSHIP (EDC)






Education for democratic citizenship means education, training and dissemination of information, practices and activities which aim to empower students to

- exercise and defend their democratic rights and responsibilities in society
- ▶ value diversity
- ▶ play an active part in democratic life, with a view to the promotion and protection of democracy and the rule of law.



WHAT IS HUMAN RIGHTS EDUCATION (HRE)

- ► Human rights education means education which aims to
 - equip learners with knowledge, skills and understanding and mould their attitudes and behaviour
 - empower learners to contribute to the building and defence of a universal culture of human rights in society
- In order to promote and protect human rights and fundamental freedoms

- Valuing human dignity and human rights
- Valuing cultural diversity
- Valuing democracy, justice, fairness, equality and the rule of law

Attitudes

- Openness to cultural otherness and to other beliefs, world views and practices
- Respect
- Civic-mindedness

- Tolerance of ambiguity

Competence

- Autonomous learning skills
- Analytical and critical thinking skills
- Skills of listening and observing
- Empathy
- Flexibility and adaptability
- Linguistic, communicative and plurilingual skills
- Co-operation skills
- Conflict-resolution skills

Skills


- Knowledge and critical understanding of the self

- ► Thinking about and developing the role of student council: how to enhance student participation in planning and decision making processes at school
- Writing letters to local businesses, organizations and policy-makers
- ▶ Thinking about children's rights and responsibilities
- ► Learning about different cultures: how to become aware of and demolish our own prejudices
