






2. The presentation by the external speakers gave me a better understanding about problems with communication












4. I feel that I got to know the other pupils in my group better.







5. Communication with the other pupils in my group went well.









7. I found it easy to gather information from the other pupils about their school, town and country.








10. There are more things the same than there are differences in the four schools.
