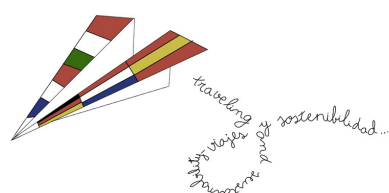


TRAVELING AND SUSTAINABILITY
