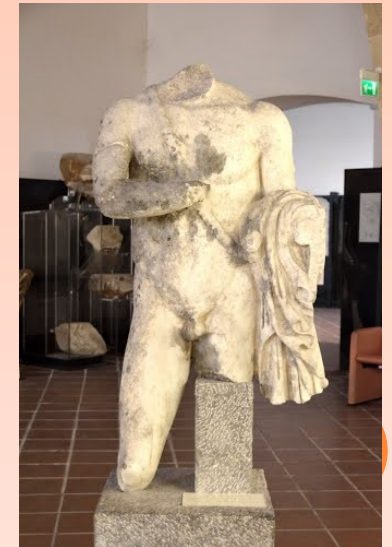

The production of salt in the salt pans of the Lagoon takes advantage of the natural elements.



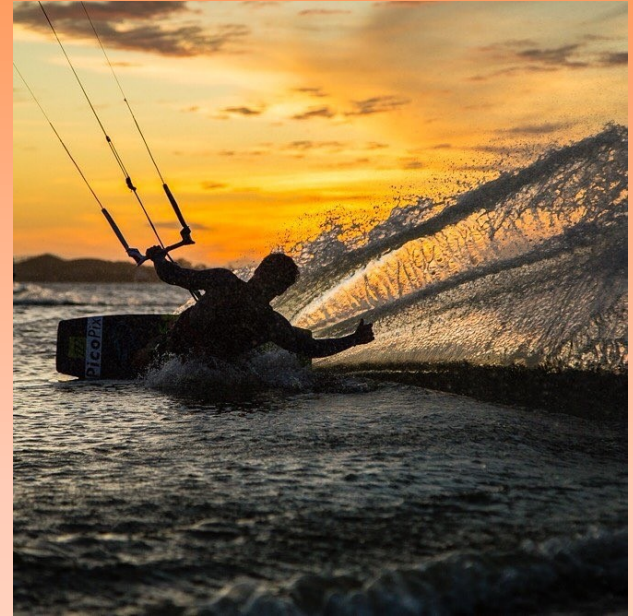

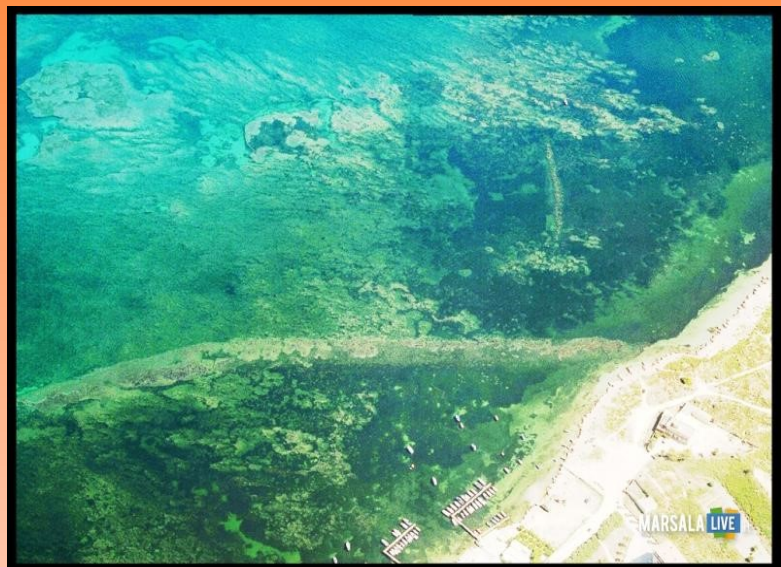

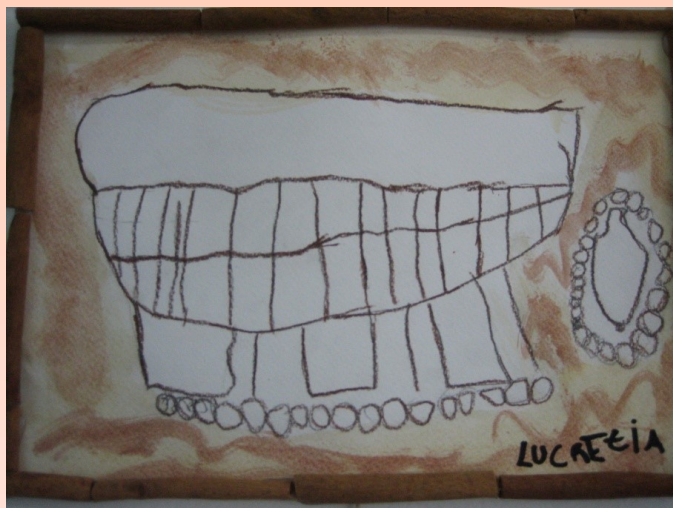
